- And Yehowah of armies will certainly make for all the **peoples**, in this mountain, a banquet of well-oiled dishes, a banquet of wine kept on the dregs, of well-oiled dishes filled with marrow, of wine kept on the dregs, filtered. (**Isaiah 25:6**)
