- The thing that Isaiah the son of Amoz visioned concerning Judah and Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 2:1**)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah **will** become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it **will certainly** be lifted up above the hills, and to it all the nations must stream. (**Isaiah 2:2**)
- And many peoples **will certainly** go and say; Come, **you** people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he **will** instruct us about his ways, and we **will** walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law **will** go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 2:3**)
- And he **will certainly** render judgment among the nations and set matters straight respecting many peoples. And they **will have** to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. Nation **will** not lift up sword against nation, neither **will** they **learn** war anymore. (**Isaiah 2:4**)
- O men of the house of Jacob, come and let us walk in the light of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 2:5**)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah **will** become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it **will certainly** be lifted up above the hills, and to it peoples must stream. (**Micah 4:1**)

- For all the peoples, for their part, **will** walk each one in the name of its god, but we, for our part, shall walk in the name of Yehowah our God to time indefinite, even forever. (**Micah 4:5**)

- At midnight I get up to give thanks to you for your righteous judicial decisions. (**Psalms 119:62**)

- O God, you are my God, I **keep looking** for you. My soul does thirst for you. For you my flesh has grown faint with longing In a **land** dry and exhausted, where there is no water. (**Psalms 63:1**)
- I **will** remember my string music in the **night**, with my heart I **will** show concern, and my **spirit will** carefully search. (**Psalms 77:6**)
- And he himself **will** judge the **productive land in righteousness**, he **will** judicially try national groups in uprightness. (**Psalms 9:8**)
- And mankind **will** say; Surely there is fruitage for the righteous one. Surely there exists a God that is judging in the earth. (**Psalms 58:11**)
- Before Yehowah. For he has come, for he has come to judge the **earth**. He **will** judge the **productive land with righteousness** and the peoples with his faithfulness. (**Psalms 96:13**)

- Clouds and thick gloom are all around him, **righteousness** and judgment are the established place of his throne. (**Psalms 97:2**)
