- And the family heads became jealous of Joseph and sold him into Egypt. But God was with him. (Acts of Apostles 7:9)
- And he delivered him out of all his tribulations and gave him graciousness and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt. And he appointed him to govern Egypt and his whole house. (Acts of Apostles 7:10)
- But a famine came upon the whole of Egypt and Canaan, even a great tribulation, and our forefathers were not finding any provisions. (Acts of Apostles 7:11)
- But Jacob heard there were foodstuffs in Egypt and he sent our forefathers out the first time. (Acts of Apostles 7:12)
- And during the second time Joseph was made known to his brothers, and the family stock of Joseph became manifest to Pharaoh. (Acts of Apostles 7:13)
- Before I was forming you in the belly I knew you, and before you proceeded to come forth from the womb I sanctified you. Prophet to the nations I made you. (Jeremiah 1:5)
- Then the kingdom of the heavens will become like ten virgins that took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. (Matthew 25:1)

- Five of them were foolish, and five were discreet. (Matthew 25:2)
- For the foolish took their lamps but took no oil with them. (Matthew 25:3)
- Whereas the discreet took oil in their receptacles with their lamps. (Matthew 25:4)
- While the bridegroom was delaying, they all nodded and went to sleep. (Matthew 25:5)
- Right in the middle of the night there arose a cry, Here is the bridegroom! Be on YOUR way out to meet him. (Matthew 25:6)
- Then all those virgins rose and put their lamps in order. (Matthew 25:7)
- The foolish said to the discreet; Give us some of YOUR oil, because our lamps are about to go out. (Matthew 25:8)
- The discreet answered with the words; Perhaps there may not be quite enough for us and you. Be on your way, instead, to those who sell it and buy for yourselves. (Matthew 25:9)
- While they were going off to buy, the bridegroom arrived, and the virgins that were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was shut. (Matthew 25:10)
- Afterwards the rest of the virgins also came, saying; Sir, sir, open to us! (Matthew 25:11)
- In answer he said; I tell you the truth, I do not know you. (Matthew 25:12)
- For just as a young man takes ownership of a virgin as his wife, your sons will take ownership of you as a wife. And with the exultation of a bridegroom over a bride, your God will exult even over you. (Isaiah 62:5)
- At this Jesus said to them; The friends of the bridegroom have no reason to mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them, do they? But days will come when the bridegroom will be taken away from them, and then they will fast. (Matthew 9:15)
- He that has the bride is the bridegroom. However, the friend of the bridegroom, when he stands and hears him, has a great deal of joy on account of the voice of the bridegroom. Therefore this joy of mine has been made full. (John 3:29)

- And Hannah went on to pray and say; My heart does exult in Yehowah, my horn is indeed exalted in Yehowah. My mouth is widened against my enemies, for I do rejoice in the salvation from you. (1 Samuel 2:1)
- And not only that, but we are also exulting in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. (Romans 5:11)
- And in that day one will certainly say; Look! This is our God. We have hoped in him, and he will save us. This is Yehowah. We have hoped in him. Let us be joyful and rejoice in the salvation by him. (Isaiah 25:9)
- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more will there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (Isaiah 52:1)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My own servants will eat, but you yourselves will go hungry. Look! My own servants will drink, but you yourselves will go thirsty. Look! My own servants will rejoice, but you yourselves will suffer shame. (Isaiah 65:13)
- And Mary said; My soul magnifies Yehowah. (Luke 1:46)
- And its priests I shall clothe with salvation, and its loyal ones will without fail cry out joyfully. (Psalms 132:16)
- I saw also the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:2)
- With righteousness I clothed myself, and it was clothing me. My justice was like a sleeveless coat, and a turban. (Job 29:14)
- Let your priests themselves be clothed with righteousness, and let your own loyal ones cry out joyfully. (Psalms 132:9)
- And you must weave in checker-work the robe of fine linen and make a turban of fine linen, and you will make a sash, the work of a weaver. (Exodus 28:39)
- To assign to those mourning over Zion, to give them a headdress instead of ashes, the oil of exultation instead of mourning, the mantle of praise instead of the downhearted spirit, and they must be called big trees of righteousness, the planting of Yehowah, for him to be beautified. (Isaiah 61:3)

- Then he made the sleeveless coat of the ephod, the workmanship of a loom worker, all of blue thread. (Exodus 39:22)
- And it is like a bridegroom when coming out of his nuptial chamber, it exults as a mighty man does to run in a path. (Psalms 19:5)
- Yehowah is my strength and my shield. In him my heart has trusted, and I have been helped, so that my heart exults, and with my song I shall laud him. (Psalms 28:7)
- And I will come to the altar of God, to God, my exultant rejoicing. And I will laud you on the harp, O God, my God. (Psalms 43:4)
- I am exulting over your saying just as one does when finding much spoil. (Psalms 119:162)
- For Yehowah is taking pleasure in his people. He beautifies the meek ones with salvation. (Psalms 149:4)
- And Egypt will not come to have any work that the head or the tail, the shoot or the rush, can do. (Isaiah 19:15)
- When they, the priests, have come in, they will not also go out from the holy place to the outer courtyard, but there they will deposit their garments in which they customarily minister, for they are something holy. They will clothe themselves with other garments, and must approach to what has to do with the people. (Ezekiel 42:14)
- And it must occur that when they come into the gates of the inner courtyard, linen garments they should wear, and no wool should come up on them when they minister in the gates of the inner courtyard and inside. (Ezekiel 44:17)
- And, you sons of Zion, be joyful and rejoice in Yehowah your God, for he will be bound to give you the autumn rain in right measure, and he will bring down upon you people a downpour, autumn rain and spring rain, as at the first. (Joel 2:23)
- Yet, as for me, I will exult in Yehowah himself, I will be joyful in the God of my salvation. (Habakkuk 3:18)
- Then he answered and said to those standing before him; Remove the befouled garments from upon him. And he went on to say to him; See, I have caused your error to pass away from upon you, and there is a clothing of you with robes of state. (Zechariah 3:4)
