**Isaiah 45:1**· This is what Yehowah has said to his anointed one, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have taken hold of, to subdue before him nations, so that I may ungird even the hips of kings, to open before him the two-leaved doors, so that even the gates will not be shut.

- Come, **you** people, behold the activities of **Yehowah**, how he **has** set astonishing events on the earth. (**Psalms 46:8**)
- He is making wars to cease to the extremity of the earth. The bow he breaks apart and does cut the spear in pieces, the wagons he burns in the fire. (**Psalms 46:9**)
- The One saying of **Cyrus**: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he **will** completely carry out. **Even** in my saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be rebuilt. And of the temple: You **will have** your foundation laid. (**Isaiah 44:28**)
- And in the first year of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, **Yehowah** roused the spirit of **Cyrus** the king of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, saying; (**Ezra 1:1**)
- But I am constantly with you, you **have taken hold** of my **right hand**. (**Psalms 73:23**)
- For the sake of my servant Jacob and of Israel my chosen one, I **even** proceeded to call you by your name, I proceeded to give you a name of honor, although you did not know me. (**Isaiah 45:4**)
- I shall make mortal man rarer than refined gold, and earthling man rarer than the gold of Ophir. (**Isaiah 13:12**)
- I **have** roused up someone from the north, and he **will** come. From the rising of the sun he **will** call upon my name. And he **will** come

upon deputy rulers as if they were clay and just as a potter that tramples down the moist material. (Isaiah 41:25)

- You are a club for me, as weapons of war, and by you I shall certainly dash **nations** to pieces, and by you I **will** bring kingdoms to ruin. (Jeremiah 51:20)
- And in the first year of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, **Yehowah** roused the spirit of **Cyrus** the king of Persia, so that he caused a cry to pass through all his kingdom, and also in writing, saying; (2 Chronicles 36:22)
- The places from which rivers trickled he **has** dammed up, and the concealed thing he brings forth to the light. (Job 28:11)
- For he **has** broken the **doors** of copper, and he **has** cut down **even** the bars of iron. (Psalms 107:16)
- And he **will** certainly render judgment among the **nations** and set matters straight respecting many peoples. And they **will have** to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. Nation **will** not lift up sword against nation, neither **will** they learn war anymore. (Isaiah 2:4)
- And **Yehowah** of armies **will** certainly brandish against him a whip as at the defeat of Midian by the rock Oreb, and his staff **will** be upon the sea, and he **will** certainly lift it up in the way that he did with Egypt. (Isaiah 10:26)
- And it must occur in that day that his load **will** depart from upon your shoulder, and his yoke from upon your neck, and the yoke **will** certainly be wrecked because of the oil. (Isaiah 10:27)
- Upon a mountain of bare rocks raise up a signal, **you** men. Lift up the voice to them, wave the **hand**, that they may come into the entrances of the nobles. (Isaiah 13:2)
- And here, now, there is coming a war chariot of men, with a span of steeds! And he began to speak up and say; She **has** fallen! Babylon **has** fallen, and all the graven images of her gods he **has** broken to the earth! (Isaiah 21:9)
- For I, **Yehowah** your God, am grasping your **right hand**, the One saying to you, Do not be afraid. I myself **will** help you. (Isaiah 41:13)

- The One calling from the sunrising a bird of prey, from a distant land the man to execute my counsel. I **have even** spoken it, I shall also bring it in. I **have** formed it, I shall also do it. (**Isaiah 46:11**)
- Be collected together, all **you** people, and hear. Who among them **has** told these things? **Yehowah** himself **has** loved him. He **will** do what is his delight upon Babylon, and his own arm **will** be upon the Chaldeans. (**Isaiah 48:14**)
- The wolf and the lamb themselves **will** feed as one, and the lion **will** eat straw just like the bull, and as for the serpent, his food **will** be dust. They **will** do no harm nor cause any ruin in all my holy mountain, **Yehowah has said**. (**Isaiah 65:25**)
- Before I was forming you in the belly I knew you, and **before** you proceeded to come forth from the womb I sanctified you. Prophet to the **nations** I made you. (**Jeremiah 1:5**)
- Look! A people is coming in from the north, and a great nation and grand **kings** themselves **will** be roused up from the remotest parts of the earth. (**Jeremiah 50:41**)
- Polish the arrows. Fill the circular shields, O men. **Yehowah has** aroused the spirit of the **kings** of the Medes, because it is against Babylon that his idea is, in order to bring her to ruin. For it is the vengeance of **Yehowah**, the vengeance for his temple. (**Jeremiah 51:11**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah has said**; Here I am against Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and I **will** break his arms, the strong one and the broken one, and I **will** cause the sword to fall out of his **hand**. (**Ezekiel 30:22**)
- And after you there **will** rise another kingdom inferior to you, and another kingdom, a third one, of copper, that **will** rule over the whole earth. (**Daniel 2:39**)
- **PERES**, your kingdom **has** been divided and given to the Medes and the Persians. (**Daniel 5:28**)
- I saw the ram making thrusts to the west and to the north and to the south, and no wild beasts kept standing **before** it, and there was no one doing any delivering out of its **hand**. And it did according to its **will**, and it put on great airs. (**Daniel 8:4**)
- In the third year of **Cyrus** the king of Persia there was a matter revealed to Daniel, **whose** name was called Belteshazzar, and the

matter was true, and there was a great military service. And he understood the matter, and he had understanding in the thing seen. (Daniel 10:1)

- The one making a breakthrough **will** certainly come up **before** them; they **will** actually break through. And they **will** pass through a gate, and they **will** go out by it. And their king **will** pass through **before** them, with **Yehowah** at the head of them. (Micah 2:13)

- For it is God's minister to you for your good. But if you are doing what is bad, be in fear; for it is not without purpose that it bears the sword, for it is God's minister, an avenger to express wrath upon the one practicing what is bad. (Romans 13:4)

- And another came forth, a fiery-colored horse, and to the one seated upon it there was granted to take peace away from the earth so that they should slaughter one another, and a great sword was given him. (Revelation 6:4)

- And the sixth one poured out his bowl upon the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, that the way might be prepared for the **kings** from the rising of the sun. (Revelation 16:12)

- That **you** may eat the fleshy parts of **kings** and the fleshy parts of military commanders and the fleshy parts of strong men and the fleshy parts of horses and of those seated upon them, and the fleshy parts of all, of freemen as well as of slaves and of small ones and great. (Revelation 19:18)

- And **you** yourselves will become to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words that you are to say to the sons of Israel. (Exodus 19:6)

- But you, O Israel, are my servant, you, O Jacob, whom I **have** chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend. (Isaiah 41:8)

- Nevertheless, when **you** did not know God, then it was that **you** slaved for those who by nature are not gods. (Galatians 4:8)

- Therefore **Yehowah** himself **will** give **you** men a sign; Look! The maiden herself **will** actually become pregnant, and she is giving birth to a son, and she **will** certainly call his name Immanuel. (Isaiah 7:14)

- And now this is what **Yehowah has said**, your Creator, O Jacob, and your Former, O Israel; Do not be afraid, for I **have** repurchased you. I **have** called you by your name. You are mine. (Isaiah 43:1)
