Isaiah 53:10. But Yehowah himself took delight in crushing him, he made him sick. If you will set his soul as a guilt offering, he will see his offspring, he will prolong his days, and in his hand what is the delight of Yehowah will succeed.

- And he proceeded to make my mouth like a sharp sword. In the shadow of his hand he has hidden me. And he gradually made me a polished arrow. He concealed me in his own quiver. (Isaiah 49:2)
- And he went on to say to me; You are my servant, O Israel, you the one in whom I shall show my beauty. (Isaiah 49:3)
- And I saw in the right hand of the One seated upon the throne a scroll written within and on the reverse side, sealed tight with seven seals. (Revelation 5:1)
- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice; Who is worthy to open the scroll and loose its seals? (Revelation 5:2)
- But neither in heaven nor upon earth nor underneath the earth was there a single one able to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:3)
- And I gave way to a great deal of weeping because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. (Revelation 5:4)
- But one of the elders says to me; Stop weeping. Look! The Lion that is of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, has conquered so as to open the scroll and its seven seals. (Revelation 5:5)
- And it came about that we went up to your slave my father and then told him the words of my master. (Genesis 44:24)
- Later our father said; Return, buy a little food for us. (Genesis 44:25)

- But we said; We are not able to go down. If our youngest brother is with us we will go down, because we are not able to see the man's face in case our youngest brother is not with us. (Genesis 44:26)
- Then your slave my father said to us, you yourselves well know that my wife bore but two sons to me. (Genesis 44:27)
- Later the one went out from my company and I exclaimed; Ah, he must surely be torn to pieces! And I have not seen him till now. (Genesis 44:28)
- If you were to take this one also out of my sight and a fatal accident were to befall him, you would certainly bring down my gray hairs with calamity to Sheol. (Genesis 44:29)
- And now, as soon as I should come to your slave my father without the boy along with us, when that one's soul is bound up with this one's soul. (Genesis 44:30)
- Then it is certain to occur that as soon as he sees that the boy is not there he will simply die, and your slaves will indeed bring down the gray hairs of your slave our father with grief to Sheol. (Genesis 44:31)
- For your slave became surety for the boy when away from his father, saying; If I fail to bring him back to you, then I shall have sinned against my father forever. (Genesis 44:32)
- So now, please, let your slave stay instead of the boy as a slave to my master, that the boy may go up with his brothers. (Genesis 44:33)
- For how can I go up to my father without the boy along with me, for fear that then I may look upon the calamity that will find out my father? (Genesis 44:34)
- But all this has taken place for the scriptures of the prophets to be fulfilled. Then all the disciples abandoned him and fled. (Matthew 26:56)
- But Yehowah proved to be with Joseph, so that he turned out a successful man and came to be over the house of his master, the Egyptian. (Genesis 39:2)
- And his master got to see that Yehowah was with him and that everything he was doing Yehowah was making turn out successful in his hand. (Genesis 39:3)

- However, Yehowah continued with Joseph and kept extending loving-kindness to him and granting him to find favor in the eyes of the chief officer of the prison house. (Genesis 39:21)
- So the chief officer of the prison house gave over into Joseph's hand all the prisoners who were in the prison house, and everything that they were doing there he proved to be the one having it done. (Genesis 39:22)
- The chief officer of the prison house was looking after absolutely nothing that was in his hand, because Yehowah was with Joseph and what he was doing Yehowah was making it turn out successful. (Genesis 39:23)
- So Pharaoh said to his servants; Can another man be found like this one in whom the spirit of God is? (Genesis 41:38)
- Finally all the land of Egypt became famished and the people began to cry to Pharaoh for bread. Then Pharaoh said to all the Egyptians; Go to Joseph. Whatever he says to you, you are to do. (Genesis 41:55)
- And Joseph was the man in power over the land. He was the one that did the selling to all people of the earth. Consequently Joseph's brothers came and bowed low to him with their faces to the earth. (Genesis 42:6)
- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because you sold me here, because for the preservation of life God has sent me ahead of you. (Genesis 45:5)
- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there will be no plowing time or harvest. (Genesis 45:6)
- Consequently God sent me ahead of you in order to place a remnant for you men in the earth and to keep you alive by a great escape. (Genesis 45:7)
- And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)
- Also, Simeon blessed them, but said to Mary its mother; Look! This one is laid for the fall and the rising again of many in Israel and for a sign to be talked against (Luke 2:34)

- And Aaron must present the bull of the sin offering, which is for himself, and make an atonement in behalf of himself and his house, and he must slaughter the bull of the sin offering, which is for himself. (Leviticus 16:11)
- The one who did not know sin he made to be sin for us, that we might become God's righteousness by means of him. (2 Corinthians 5:21)
- He does not need daily, as those High Priests do, to offer up sacrifices, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, for this he did once for all time when he offered himself up. (Hebrews 7:27)
- Your people will offer themselves willingly on the day of your military force. In the splendors of holiness, from the womb of the dawn, you have your company of young men just like dewdrops. (Psalms 110:3)
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies will do this. (Isaiah 9:7)
- It is even so written: The first man Adam became a living soul. The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. (1 Corinthians 15:45)
- And again; I will have my trust in him. And again; Look! I and the young children, whom Yehowah gave me. (Hebrews 2:13)
- The desire of his heart you have given him, and the wish of his lips you have not withheld. (Psalms 21:2)
- For you proceeded to meet him with blessings of good, and to place on his head a crown of refined gold. (Psalms 21:3)
- Life he asked of you. You gave it to him, length of days to time indefinite, even forever. (Psalms 21:4)
- His glory is great in your salvation. Dignity and splendor you put upon him. (Psalms 21:5)

- For you constitute him highly blessed forever, you make him feel glad with the rejoicing at your face. (Psalms 21:6)
- In his days the righteous one will sprout, and the abundance of peace until the moon is no more. (Psalms 72:7)
- Let his name prove to be to time indefinite, before the sun let his name have increase, and by means of him let them bless themselves, let all nations pronounce him happy. (Psalms 72:17)
- In that he made known to us the sacred secret of his will. It is according to his good pleasure which he purposed in himself (Ephesians 1:9)
- And through him to reconcile again to himself all other things by making peace through the blood he shed on the torture stake, no matter whether they are the things upon the earth or the things in the heavens. (Colossians 1:20)
- Jesus said to them; My food is for me to do the will of him that sent me and to finish his work. (John 4:34)
- What, then, shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who will be against us? (Romans 8:31)
- And as his guilt offering he will bring to Yehowah a sound ram from the flock according to the estimated value, for a guilt offering, to the priest. (Leviticus 6:6)

- And as regards the arms of the flood, they will be flooded over on account of him, and they will be broken, as will also the Leader of the covenant. (Daniel 11:22)

- About the ninth hour Jesus called out with a loud voice, saying; Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? That is, My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? (Matthew 27:46)
- For even the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (Mark 10:45)
- But getting into an agony he continued praying more earnestly,
 and his sweat became as drops of blood falling to the ground. (Luke
 22:44)
- For they did not yet discern the scripture that he must rise from the dead. (John 20:9)
- In order to do what things your hand and counsel had foreordained to occur. (Acts of Apostles 4:28)
- And that he was buried, yes, that he has been raised up the third day according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:4)
- For the love the Christ has compels us, because this is what we have judged, that one man died for all, so, then, all had died. (2 Corinthians 5:14)
