- After these things the word of Yehowah came to Abram in a vision, saying; Do not fear, Abram. I am a **shield** for you. Your reward will be very great. (**Genesis 15:1**)
- My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my **shield** and my horn of salvation, my secure height, and my place for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (**2 Samuel 22:3**)
- And yet you, O Yehowah, are a **shield** about me, my glory and the One lifting up my head. (**Psalms 3:3**)
- For Yehowah God is a sun and a **shield**, favor and glory are what he gives. Yehowah himself will not hold back anything good from those walking in faultlessness. (**Psalms 84:11**)
- As for me, in your loving-kindness I **have trusted**, let my **heart** be joyful in your salvation. (**Psalms 13:5**)
- In union with God I shall praise his word. In God I **have** put my trust, I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me? (**Psalms 56:4**)
- Without fail I shall exult in Yehowah. My soul will be joyful in my God. For he **has** clothed me with the garments of salvation, with the sleeveless coat of righteousness he **has** enwrapped me, like the

bridegroom who, in a priestly way, puts on a headdress, and like the bride who decks herself with her ornamental things. (Isaiah 61:10)

- At that time Moses and the sons of Israel proceeded to sing this **song** to Yehowah and to say the following; Let me sing to Yehowah, for he **has** become highly exalted the horse and its rider he **has** pitched into the sea. (Exodus 15:1)

- Dignity and splendor are before him, **strength** and joy are at his place. (1 Chronicles 16:27)

- I will rejoice and exult in you, I will make melody to your name, O Most High. (Psalms 9:2)

- The true God is the One girding me closely with vital energy, and he will grant my way to be perfect. (Psalms 18:32)

- For in him our **heart** rejoices, for in his holy name we **have** put our trust. (Psalms 33:21)

- For you are the God of my fortress. Why **have** you cast me off? Why do I walk about sad because of the oppression by the enemy? (Psalms 43:2)

- I will praise the name of God with **song**, and I will magnify him with thanksgiving. (Psalms 69:30)

- Happy are the men whose **strength** is in you, in whose **heart** are the highways. (Psalms 84:5)

- Turn to me and show me favor. Do give your **strength** to your servant, and do save the son of your slave girl. (Psalms 86:16)

- For you are the beauty of their **strength**, and by your goodwill our horn is exalted. (Psalms 89:17)

- For there those holding us captive asked us for the words of a **song**, and those mocking us, for rejoicing; **SING** for us one of the **songs** of Zion. (Psalms 137:3)

• Who among **you** people is in fear of Yehowah, listening to the voice of his servant, who **has** walked in continual darkness and for whom there **has** been no brightness? Let him trust in the name of Yehowah and support himself upon his God. (**Isaiah 50:10**)

• And, **you** sons of Zion, be joyful and rejoice in Yehowah **YOUR** God, for he will be bound to give **you** the autumn rain in right measure, and he will bring down upon **you** people a downpour, autumn rain and spring rain, as at the first. (**Joel 2:23**)
