CHRIST - YEHOWAH SAYS TO CHRIST - SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND

Messianic ··· Prophecy ··· Christ - Yehowah says to Christ, sit at my right hand until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet (Psalms 110:1) [40] - References

Psalms 110:1... The utterance of Yehowah to my Lord is; Sit at my right hand until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet.

[40] - References

- He said to them; How, then, is it that David by inspiration calls him Lord, saying; (Matthew 22:43)
- For David himself says in the book of Psalms: Yehowah said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand (Luke 20:42)
- By the Holy Spirit David himself said; Yehowah said to my Lord;
 Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies beneath your feet. (Mark 12:36)
- Actually David did not ascend to the heavens, but he himself says, Yehowah said to my Lord: Sit at my right hand. (Acts of Apostles 2:34)
- And he said; Look! I behold the heavens opened up and the Son of man standing at God's right hand. (Acts of Apostles 7:56)
- Who is he that will condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died, yes, rather the one who was raised up from the dead, who is on the right hand of God, who also pleads for us. (Romans 8:34)
- With which he has operated in the case of the Christ when he raised him up from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places. (Ephesians 1:20)
- If, however, you were raised up with the Christ, go on seeking the things above, where the Christ is seated at the right hand of God. (Colossians 3:1)
- He is the reflection of his glory and the exact representation of his very being, and he sustains all things by the word of his power, and after he had made a purification for our sins he sat down on the right hand of the Majesty in lofty places. (Hebrews 1:3)

- Now as to the things being discussed this is the main point; We have such a High Priest as this, and he has sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens. (Hebrews 8:1)
- But this man offered one sacrifice for sins perpetually and sat down at the right hand of God. (Hebrews 10:12)
- As we look intently at the Chief Agent and Perfecter of our faith, Jesus. For the joy that was set before him he endured a torture stake, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2)
- He is at God's right hand, for he went his way to heaven, and angels and authorities and powers were made subject to him. (1 Peter 3:22)
- Yehowah said to my Lord; Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies beneath your feet? (Matthew 22:44)
- Until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet. (Acts of Apostles 2:35)
- For he must rule as king until God has put all enemies under his feet (1 Corinthians 15:25)
- But with reference to which one of the angels has he ever said; Sit at my right hand, until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet? (Hebrews 1:13)
- From then on awaiting until his enemies should be placed as a stool for his feet. (Hebrews 10:13)
- However, Israel put out his right hand and placed it on Ephraim's head, although he was the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head. He purposely laid his hands so, since Manasseh was the firstborn. (Genesis 48:14)
- And it came about that as soon as they had brought out these kings to Joshua, Joshua proceeded to call all the men of Israel and to say to the commanders of the men of war that had gone with him; Come forward. Place YOUR feet on the back of the necks of these kings. So they came forward and placed their feet on the back of their necks. (Joshua 10:24)
- As for Yehowah, those contending against him will be terrified, Against them he will thunder in the heavens. Yehowah himself will judge the ends of the earth, that he may give strength to his king, that he may exalt the horn of his anointed one. (1 Samuel 2:10)

- And I shall exterminate them and break them in pieces, that they may not rise up, and they will fall under my feet. (2 Samuel 22:39)
- The true God is the Giver of acts of vengeance to me and the One bringing the peoples down under me. (2 Samuel 22:48)
- So Bath-sheba came in to King Solomon to speak to him for Adonijah. At once the king rose to meet her and bowed down to her. Then he sat down upon his throne and had a throne set for the mother of the king, that she might sit at his right. (1 Kings 2:19)
- Before him the inhabitants of waterless regions will bow down, and his very enemies will lick the dust itself. (Psalms 72:9)
- Let your hand prove to be upon the man of your right hand, upon the son of mankind whom you have made strong for yourself. (Psalms 80:17)
- And from before him I crushed his adversaries to pieces, and to those intensely hating him I kept dealing out blows. (Psalms 89:23)
- Before you I myself shall go, and the swells of land I shall straighten out. The copper doors I shall break in pieces, and the iron bars I shall cut down. (Isaiah 45:2)
- Look! My servant will act with insight. He will be in high station and will certainly be elevated and exalted very much. (Isaiah 52:13)
- To you the very glory of Lebanon will come, the juniper tree, the ash tree and the cypress at the same time, in order to beautify the place of my sanctuary, and I shall glorify the very place of my feet. (Isaiah 60:13)
- And his majestic one will certainly come to be from him, and from the midst of him his own ruler will go forth, and I will cause him to come near, and he must approach to me. For who, now, is this one that has given his heart in pledge in order to approach to me? is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 30:21)
- A ruin, a ruin, a ruin I shall make it. As for this also, it will certainly become no one's until he comes who has the legal right, and I must give it to him. (Ezekiel 21:27)
- And during that time Michael will stand up, the great prince who is standing in behalf of the sons of your people. And there will certainly occur a time of distress such as has not been made to occur since there came to be a nation until that time. And during that time

your people will escape, every one who is found written down in the book. (Daniel 12:1)

- Jesus said to him; You yourself said it. Yet I say to you men, From henceforth you will see the Son of man sitting at the right hand of power and coming on the clouds of heaven. (Matthew 26:64)
- Then Jesus said; I am, and you persons will see the Son of man sitting at the right hand of power and coming with the clouds of heaven. (Mark 14:62)
- Until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet. (Luke 20:43)
- However, from now on the Son of man will be sitting at the powerful right hand of God. (Luke 22:69)
- Whom heaven, indeed, must hold within itself until the times of restoration of all things of which God spoke through the mouth of his holy prophets of old time. (Acts of Apostles 3:21)
- But he, being full of Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and caught sight of God's glory and of Jesus standing at God's right hand. (Acts of Apostles 7:55)
- All things you subjected under his feet. For in that he subjected all things to him God left nothing that is not subject to him. Now, though, we do not yet see all things in subjection to him. (Hebrews 2:8)
