- Eventually Jacob got to see that there were cereals in Egypt. Then Jacob said to his sons; Why do you keep looking at one another? (Genesis 42:1)
- And he added; Here I have heard that there are cereals in Egypt. Go down there and buy for us from there, that we may keep alive and not die off. (Genesis 42:2)
- And the famine was severe in the land. (Genesis 43:1)
- And it came about that as soon as they had finished eating up the cereals they had brought from Egypt, their father proceeded to say to them; Return, buy a little food for us. (Genesis 43:2)
- Then Judah said to him; The man unmistakably bore witness to us, saying; You must not see my face again unless your brother is with you. (Genesis 43:3)
- If you are sending our brother with us, we are willing to go down and buy food for you. (Genesis 43:4)
- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because you sold me here, because for the preservation of life God has sent me ahead of you. (Genesis 45:5)
- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there will be no plowing time or harvest. (Genesis 45:6)

- Consequently God sent me ahead of you in order to place a remnant for you men in the earth and to keep you alive by a great escape. (Genesis 45:7)
- And he sent Judah in advance of him to Joseph to impart information ahead of him to Goshen. After that they came into the land of Goshen. (Genesis 46:28)
- Then Joseph had his chariot made ready and went up to meet Israel his father at Goshen. When he appeared to him he at once fell upon his neck and gave way to tears upon his neck again and again. (Genesis 46:29)
- Finally Israel said to Joseph; This time I am willing to die, now that I have seen your face, since you are still alive. (Genesis 46:30)
- And the family heads became jealous of Joseph and sold him into Egypt. But God was with him. (Acts of Apostles 7:9)
- And he delivered him out of all his tribulations and gave him graciousness and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt. And he appointed him to govern Egypt and his whole house. (Acts of Apostles 7:10)
- But a famine came upon the whole of Egypt and Canaan, even a great tribulation, and our forefathers were not finding any provisions. (Acts of Apostles 7:11)
- But Jacob heard there were foodstuffs in Egypt and he sent our forefathers out the first time. (Acts of Apostles 7:12)
- And during the second time Joseph was made known to his brothers, and the family stock of Joseph became manifest to Pharaoh. (Acts of Apostles 7:13)
- Listen to me, O you islands, and pay attention, you national groups far away. Yehowah himself has called me even from the belly. From the inward parts of my mother he has made mention of my name. (Isaiah 49:1)
- The utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, who is collecting together the dispersed ones of Israel, is; I shall collect together to him others besides those already collected together of his. (Isaiah 56:8)
- In answer he said; I was not sent forth to any but to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. (Matthew 15:24)

- He sent out the word to the sons of Israel to declare to them the Good News of peace through Jesus Christ. This One is Lord of all others. (Acts of Apostles 10:36)
