- Messianic ··· Prophecy ··· Christ Yehowah will comfort Zion raising up her devastated places and he will make her dry places like the garden of Yehowah, Exultation and rejoicing will be found in her thanksgiving and song · (Isaiah 51:3) [28] - References
- Isaiah 51:3" For Yehowah will certainly comfort Zion. He will for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he will make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of Yehowah. Exultation and rejoicing themselves will be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody.

- Later they heard the voice of Yehowah God walking in the garden about the breezy part of the day, and the man and his wife went into hiding from the face of Yehowah God in between the trees of the garden. (Genesis 3:8)
- Sing to Yehowah a new song. Sing to Yehowah, all you people of the earth. (Psalms 96:1)
- Sing to Yehowah, bless his name. From day to day tell the Good News of salvation by him. (Psalms 96:2)
- Declare among the nations his glory, among all the peoples his wonderful works. (Psalms 96:3)
- For Yehowah is great and very much to be praised. He is fear-inspiring above all other gods. (Psalms 96:4)
- Sing to Yehowah a new song, his praise from the extremity of the earth, you men that are going down to the sea and to that which fills it, you islands and you inhabiting them. (Isaiah 42:10)
- Speaking to yourselves with psalms and praises to God and spiritual songs, singing and accompanying yourselves with music in YOUR hearts to Yehowah. (Ephesians 5:19)
- The wilderness and the waterless region will exult, and the desert plain will be joyful and blossom as the saffron. (Isaiah 35:1)

- Upon bare hills I shall open up rivers, and in the midst of the valley plains, springs. I shall make the wilderness into a reedy pool of water, and the waterless land into sources of water. (Isaiah 41:18)
- The One making the word of his servant come true, and the One that carries out completely the counsel of his own messengers, the One saying of Jerusalem, She will be inhabited, and of the cities of Judah, They will be rebuilt, and her desolated places I shall raise up. (Isaiah 44:26)
- And they must rebuild the long-standing devastated places, they will raise up even the desolated places of former times, and they will certainly make anew the devastated cities, the places desolate for generation after generation. (Isaiah 61:4)
- Like a man whom his own mother keeps comforting, so I myself shall keep comforting you people, and in the case of Jerusalem you will be comforted. (Isaiah 66:13)
- And they will certainly come and cry out joyfully on the height of Zion and become radiant over the goodness of Yehowah, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul will simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more will they languish again. (Jeremiah 31:12)
- The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; LAUD Yehowah of armies, for Yehowah is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness! They will be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of Yehowah, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 33:11)
- Judah and Israel were many, like the grains of sand that are by the sea for multitude, eating and drinking and rejoicing. (1 Kings 4:20)
- You yourself will arise, you will have mercy on Zion, for it is the season to be favorable to her, for the appointed time has come. (Psalms 102:13)
- Further, Yehowah God planted a garden in Eden, toward the east, and there he put the man whom he had formed. (Genesis 2:8)
- So Lot raised his eyes and saw the whole District of the Jordan, that all of it was a well watered region before Yehowah brought Sodom and Gomorrah to ruin, like the garden of Yehowah, like the land of Egypt as far as Zoar. (Genesis 13:10)

- Ahead of it a fire has devoured, and behind it a flame consumes. Like the garden of Eden the land is ahead of it, but behind it is a desolate wilderness, and there has also proved to be nothing thereof escaping. (Joel 2:3)
- Zion heard and began to rejoice, and the dependent towns of Judah began to be joyful by reason of your judicial decisions, O Yehowah. (Psalms 97:8)
- My eyes have pined away for your saying, while I say; When will you comfort me? (Psalms 119:82)
- They will not do any harm or cause any ruin in all my holy mountain, because the earth will certainly be filled with the knowledge of Yehowah as the waters are covering the very sea. (Isaiah 11:9)
- Although there are your devastated places and your desolated places and the land of your ruins, although now you are too cramped to be dwelling, and those swallowing you down have been far away. (Isaiah 49:19)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am extending to her peace just like a river and the glory of nations just like a flooding torrent, and you will certainly suck. Upon the flank you will be carried, and upon the knees you will be fondled. (Isaiah 66:12)
- At that time the virgin will rejoice in the dance, also the young men and the old men, all together. And I will change their mourning into exultation, and I will comfort them and make them rejoice away from their grief. (Jeremiah 31:13)
- And you yourselves, O mountains of Israel, will give forth your very own boughs and bear your own fruitage for my people Israel, for they have drawn near to the point of coming in. (Ezekiel 36:8)
- And I will multiply upon you humankind, the whole house of Israel, all of it, and the cities must become inhabited, and the devastated places themselves will be rebuilt. (Ezekiel 36:10)
- And people will certainly say; That land yonder which was laid desolate has become like the garden of Eden, and the cities that were a waste and that were laid desolate and that were torn down are fortified, they have become inhabited. (Ezekiel 36:35)
- Do not be fearful, you beasts of the open field, for the pasture grounds of the wilderness will certainly grow green. For the tree will

actually give its fruitage. The fig tree and the vine must give their vital energy. (Joel 2:22)

- Call out further, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; My cities will yet overflow with goodness, and Yehowah will yet certainly feel regrets over Zion and yet actually choose Jerusalem. (Zechariah 1:17)
