Psalms 7:8" Yehowah himself will pass sentence on the peoples. Judge me, O Yehowah, according to my righteousness and according to my integrity in me.

[20] - References

- It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one so that it has to occur with the righteous man as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the earth not going to do what is right? (Genesis 18:25)
- And he himself will judge the productive land in righteousness, he will judicially try national groups in uprightness. (Psalms 9:8)
- Yehowah rewards me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands he repays me. (Psalms 18:20)
- Judge me according to your righteousness, O Yehowah my God,
  and may they not rejoice over me. (Psalms 35:24)
- It is unthinkable on my part that I should declare you men righteous! Until I expire I shall not take away my integrity from myself! (Job 27:5)
- As for me, in my integrity I shall walk. O redeem me and show me favor. (Psalms 26:11)
- As for me, because of my integrity you have upheld me, and you will set me before your face to time indefinite. (Psalms 41:12)
- And he began to shepherd them according to the integrity of his heart, and with the skillfulness of his hands he began leading them. (Psalms 78:72)
- Anyone of little means who is walking in his integrity is better than the one crooked in his lips, and the one that is stupid. (Proverbs 19:1)

- For Yehowah will judge his people and he will feel regret over his servants, because he will see that support has disappeared and there is only a helpless and worthless one. (Deuteronomy 32:36)
- May Yehowah judge between me and you, and Yehowah must take vengeance for me from you, but my own hand will not come to be upon you. (1 Samuel 24:12)
- And Yehowah it is who will repay to each one his own righteousness and his own faithfulness, in that Yehowah today gave you into my hand, and I was unwilling to thrust my hand out against the anointed of Yehowah. (1 Samuel 26:23)
