• Without fail I shall **exult** in **Yehowah**. My soul **will** be **joyful** in my **God**. For he has clothed me with the garments of **salvation**, with the sleeveless coat of righteousness he has enwrapped me, like the bridegroom who, in a priestly way, puts on a headdress, and like the bride who decks herself with her ornamental things. **(Isaiah 61:10)**

• Through whom also we have gained our approach by faith into this undeserved kindness in which we now stand, and let us **exult**, based on hope of the glory of **God**. **(Romans 5:2)**

• And not only that, but we are also exulting in **God** through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. **(Romans 5:11)**

• My strength and **my** might is Yah, since he serves for my **salvation**. This is my **God**, and I shall laud him, my father's **God**, and I shall raise him on high. **(Exodus 15:2)**

• **Yehowah** is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of escape for me. My **God** is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of **salvation**, my secure height. **(Psalms 18:2)**

• Look! **God** is my **salvation**. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, **Yehowah** is my strength and my might, and he came to be the **salvation** of me. **(Isaiah 12:2)**

• Because my eyes have seen your means of saving **(Luke 2:30)**

- And it became very distressing to David, because the people said to stone him, for the soul of all the people had become bitter, each one because of his sons and his daughters. So David took to strengthening himself by **Yehowah** his **God**. (**1 Samuel 30:6**)
- In order that I may declare all your praiseworthy deeds in the gates of the daughter of Zion, that I may be **joyful** in your **salvation**. (**Psalms 9:14**)
- But let my own soul be **joyful** in **Yehowah**, let it **exult** in his **salvation**. (**Psalms 35:9**)
- Rejoice in **Yehowah**, O **you** righteous ones, and give thanks to his holy memorial. (**Psalms 97:12**)
- For you have forgotten the **God** of your **salvation**, and the Rock of your fortress you have not remembered. That is why you plant pleasant plantations, and with the shoot of a stranger you set it. (**Isaiah 17:10**)
- To you, O **Yehowah**, I shall call, for fire itself has devoured the pasture grounds of the wilderness, and a very flame has consumed all the trees of the field. (**Joel 1:19**)
- And, **you** sons of Zion, be **joyful** and rejoice in **Yehowah** **your** **God**, for he **will** be bound to give **you** the autumn rain in right measure, and he **will** bring down upon **you** people a downpour, autumn rain and spring rain, as at the first. (**Joel 2:23**)
- Rejoice and leap for joy, since **your** reward is great in the heavens, for in that way they persecuted the prophets prior to **you**. (**Matthew 5:12**)
