## CHRIST - YOU ARE A PRIEST TO TIME INDEFINITE LIKE MELCHIZEDEK

Psalms 110:4" Yehowah has sworn, and he will feel no regret; You are a priest to time indefinite according to the manner of Melchizedek!

[21] - References

- For when God made his promise to Abraham, since he could not swear by anyone greater, he swore by himself. (Hebrews 6:13)
- God is not a man that he should tell lies, neither a son of mankind that he should feel regret. Has he himself said it and will he not do it, and has he spoken and will he not carry it out? (Numbers 23:19)
- For the gifts and the calling of God are not things he will regret. (Romans 11:29)
- Just as he says also in another place: You are a priest forever according to the manner of Melchizedek. (Hebrews 5:6)
- Also, to the extent that it was not without a sworn oath. (Hebrews 7:20)
- For there are indeed men that have become priests without a sworn oath, but there is one with an oath sworn by the One who said respecting him; Yehowah has sworn, and he will feel no regret, You are a priest forever. (Hebrews 7:21)
- For the Law appoints men High Priests having weakness, but the word of the sworn oath that came after the Law appoints a Son, who is perfected forever. (Hebrews 7:28)
- And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine, and he was priest of the Most High God. (Genesis 14:18)
- And he himself will build the temple of Yehowah, and he, for his part, will carry the dignity, and he must sit down and rule on his throne, and he must become a priest upon his throne, and the very

counsel of peace will prove to be between both of them. (Zechariah 6:13)

- Just as he says also in another place: You are a priest forever according to the manner of Melchizedek. (Hebrews 5:6)
- Where a forerunner has entered in our behalf, Jesus, who has become a High Priest according to the manner of Melchizedek forever. (Hebrews 6:20)
- In being fatherless, motherless, without genealogy, having neither a beginning of days nor an end of life, but having been made like the Son of God, he remains a priest perpetually. (Hebrews 7:3)
- If, then, perfection were really through the Levitical priesthood, for with it as a feature the people were given the Law, what further need would there be for another priest to arise according to the manner of Melchizedek and not said to be according to the manner of Aaron? (Hebrews 7:11)
- For in witness it is said; You are a priest forever according to the manner of Melchizedek. (Hebrews 7:17)
- And, besides, the Excellency of Israel will not prove false, and He will not feel regrets, for He is not an earthling man so as to feel regrets. (1 Samuel 15:29)
- Once I have sworn in my holiness, to David I will not tell lies. (Psalms 89:35)
- Yehowah has sworn to David, truly he will not draw back from it: Of the fruitage of your belly I shall set on your throne. (Psalms 132:11)
- Therefore the crowd answered him; We heard from the Law that the Christ remains forever, and how is it you say that the Son of man must be lifted up? Who is this Son of man? (John 12:34)
- Because he has been specifically called by God a High Priest according to the manner of Melchizedek. (Hebrews 5:10)
- And it is still more abundantly clear that with a similarity to Melchizedek there arises another priest. (Hebrews 7:15)
- But now Jesus has obtained a more excellent public service, so that he is also the mediator of a correspondingly better covenant, which has been legally established upon better promises. (Hebrews 8:6)
