

CHRIST - YOU ARE A PRIEST TO TIME INDEFINITE LIKE MELCHIZEDEK

References

Psalms 110:4... Yehowah has sworn, and he will feel no regret; You are a priest to time indefinite according to the manner of Melchizedek!

[21] - References

- For when God made his promise to Abraham, since he could not swear by anyone greater, he swore by himself. (**Hebrews 6:13**)
- God is not a man that he should tell lies, neither a son of mankind that he should **feel regret**. Has he himself said it and **will** he not do it, and **has** he spoken and **will** he not carry it out? (**Numbers 23:19**)
- For the gifts and the calling of God are not things he **will regret**. (**Romans 11:29**)
- Just as he says also in another place: **You** are a **priest** forever according to the **manner** of **Melchizedek**. (**Hebrews 5:6**)
- Also, to the extent that it was not without a **sworn** oath. (**Hebrews 7:20**)
- For there are indeed men that have become **priests** without a **sworn** oath, but there is one with an oath **sworn** by the One who said respecting him; Yehowah **has sworn**, and he **will feel** no **regret**, You are a **priest** forever. (**Hebrews 7:21**)
- For the Law appoints men High **Priests** having weakness, but the word of the **sworn** oath that came after the Law appoints a Son, who is perfected forever. (**Hebrews 7:28**)
- And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine, and he was **priest** of the Most High God. (**Genesis 14:18**)
- And he himself **will** build the temple of Yehowah, and he, for his part, **will** carry the dignity, and he must sit down and rule on his throne, and he must become a **priest** upon his throne, and the very

counsel of peace **will** prove to be between both of them. (**Zechariah 6:13**)

- Just as he says also in another place: **You** are a **priest** forever according to the **manner** of **Melchizedek**. (**Hebrews 5:6**)
- Where a forerunner **has** entered in our behalf, Jesus, who **has** become a High Priest according to the **manner** of Melchizedek forever. (**Hebrews 6:20**)
- In being fatherless, motherless, without genealogy, having neither a beginning of days nor an end of life, but having been made like the Son of God, he remains a **priest** perpetually. (**Hebrews 7:3**)
- If, then, perfection were really through the Levitical priesthood, for with it as a feature the people were given the Law, what further need would there be for another **priest** to arise according to the **manner** of Melchizedek and not said to be according to the **manner** of Aaron? (**Hebrews 7:11**)
- For in witness it is said; **You** are a **priest** forever according to the **manner** of **Melchizedek**. (**Hebrews 7:17**)
- And, besides, the Excellency of Israel **will** not prove false, and He **will** not **feel regrets**, for He is not an earthling man so as to **feel** regrets. (**1 Samuel 15:29**)
- Once I have **sworn** in my holiness, to David I **will** not tell lies. (**Psalms 89:35**)
- Yehowah **has sworn** to David, truly he **will** not draw back from it: Of the fruitage of your belly I shall set on your throne. (**Psalms 132:11**)
- Therefore the crowd answered him; We heard from the Law that the Christ remains forever, and how is it you say that the Son of man must be lifted up? Who is this Son of man? (**John 12:34**)
- Because he **has** been specifically called by God a High Priest according to the **manner** of Melchizedek. (**Hebrews 5:10**)
- And it is still more abundantly clear that with a similarity to Melchizedek there arises another **priest**. (**Hebrews 7:15**)
- But now Jesus **has** obtained a more excellent public service, so that he is also the mediator of a correspondingly better covenant, which **has** been legally established upon better promises. (**Hebrews 8:6**)
