Matthew 2:6 And you, O Bethlehem of the land of Judah, are by no means the most insignificant city among the governors of Judah, for out of you will come forth a governing one, who will shepherd my people, Israel.

- And you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, the one too little to get to be **among** the thousands of **Judah**, from you there **will come out** to me the one who is to become ruler in **Israel**, whose origin is from early times, from the days of time indefinite. (**Micah 5:2**)
- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my **shepherd**, and all that I delight in he **will** completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be rebuilt. And of the temple: You **will** have your foundation laid. (**Isaiah 44:28**)
- Both yesterday and previously while Saul happened to be king over us, you yourself became the one leading **Israel out** and bringing it in. And Yehowah proceeded to say to you, You yourself **will shepherd** my **people Israel**, and you yourself **will** become leader over **Israel**. (**2 Samuel 5:2**)
- Then they pulled away from Bethel. And while there was yet a good stretch of **land** before coming to Ephrath, Rachel proceeded to give birth, and it was going hard with her in making the delivery. (**Genesis 35:16**)
- And as for me, when I was coming from Paddan, Rachel died alongside me in the **land** of Canaan on the way while there was yet a good stretch of **land** before coming to Ephrath, so that I buried her there on the way to Ephrath, that is to say, Bethlehem. (**Genesis 48:7**)

- The scepter **will** not turn aside from **Judah**, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh **comes**, and to him the obedience of the **peoples will** belong. (**Genesis 49:10**)
- And his concubine began to commit fornication against him. Finally she went away from him to the house of her father at Bethlehem in **Judah** and continued there fully four months. (**Judges 19:2**)
- Now David was the son of this Ephrathite from Bethlehem of **Judah** whose name was Jesse. And he had eight sons. And in the days of Saul the man was already old **among** men. (**1 Samuel 17:12**)
- For **Judah** himself proved to be superior **among** his brothers, and the one for leader was from him, but the right as firstborn was Josephs. (**1 Chronicles 5:2**)
- The men of Bethlehem and Netophah, a hundred and eighty-eight. (**Nehemiah 7:26**)
- Of course, Joseph also went up from Galilee, **out** of the **city** of Nazareth, into Judea, to David's **city**, which is called Bethlehem, because of his being a member of the house and family of David. (**Luke 2:4**)
