CHRIST - YOU WILL NOT LEAVE MY SOUL IN SHEOL

Psalms 16:10. For you will not leave my soul in Sheol. You will not allow your loyal one to see the pit.

[26] - References

- However, God himself will redeem my soul from the hand of Sheol, for he will receive me. (Psalms 49:15)
- Sheol and the place of destruction are in front of Yehowah. How much more so the hearts of the sons of mankind! (Proverbs 15:11)
- He saw beforehand and spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that neither was he forsaken in Hades nor did his flesh see corruption. (Acts of Apostles 2:31)
- Whereas you killed the Chief Agent of life. But God raised him up from the dead, of which fact we are witnesses. (Acts of Apostles 3:15)
- And the living one, and I became dead, but, look! I am living forever and ever, and I have the keys of death and of Hades. (Revelation 1:18)
- O that in Sheol you would conceal me, that you would keep me secret until your anger turns back, that you would set a time limit for me and remember me! (Job 14:13)
- To the pit I shall have to call out; You are my father! To the maggot; My mother and my sister! (Job 17:14)
- Look! For peace I had what was bitter, yes, bitter, and you yourself have become attached to my soul and kept it from the pit of disintegration. For you have thrown behind your back all my sins. (Isaiah 38:17)
- Hence he also says in another psalm: You will not allow your loyal one to see corruption. (Acts of Apostles 13:35)

- If you were to take this one also out of my sight and a fatal accident were to befall him, you would certainly bring down my gray hairs with calamity to Sheol. (Genesis 44:29)
- O Yehowah, you have brought up my soul from Sheol itself, you have kept me alive, that I should not go down into the pit. (Psalms 30:3)
- O may not the flowing stream of waters wash me away, nor the depth swallow me up, nor the well close its mouth over me. (Psalms 69:15)
- Yah corrected me severely, but he did not give me over to death itself. (Psalms 118:18)
- And said; Out of my distress I called out to Yehowah, and he proceeded to answer me. Out of the belly of Sheol I cried for help. You heard my voice. (Jonah 2:2)
- To the bottoms of the mountains I went down. As for the earth, its bars were upon me for time indefinite. But out of the pit you proceeded to bring up my life, O Yehowah my God. (Jonah 2:6)
- From that time forward Jesus Christ commenced showing his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the older men and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised up. (Matthew 16:21)
- Then he took the twelve aside and said to them; Look! We are going up to Jerusalem, and all the things written by means of the prophets as to the Son of man will be completed. (Luke 18:31)
- He now said to them; These are my words which I spoke to you while I was yet with you, that all the things written in the Law of Moses and in the Prophets and Psalms about me must be fulfilled. (Luke 24:44)
- For they did not yet discern the scripture that he must rise from the dead. (John 20:9)
- But God resurrected him by loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to continue to be held fast by it. (Acts of Apostles 2:24)
- Because you will not leave my soul in Hades, neither will you allow your loyal one to see corruption. (Acts of Apostles 2:27)

- Explaining and proving by references that it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead, and saying; This is the Christ, this Jesus whom I am publishing to YOU. (Acts of Apostles 17:3)
- Further, because he was desiring to go across into Achaia, the brothers wrote the disciples, exhorting them to receive him kindly. So when he got there, he greatly helped those who had believed on account of God's undeserved kindness. (Acts of Apostles 18:27)
- That the Christ was to suffer and, as the first to be resurrected from the dead, he was going to publish light both to this people and to the nations. (Acts of Apostles 26:23)
- But who with power was declared God's Son according to the spirit of holiness by means of resurrection from the dead, yes, Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 1:4)
- And that he was buried, yes, that he has been raised up the third day according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:4)
