- And I saw a great white throne and the one seated on it. From before him the earth and the heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. (Revelation 20:11)
- And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. But another scroll was opened, it is the scroll of life. And the dead were judged out of those things written in the scrolls according to their deeds. (Revelation 20:12)
- And the sea gave up those dead in it, and death and Hades gave up those dead in them, and they were judged individually according to their deeds. (Revelation 20:13)
- But now they are reaching out for a better place, that is, one belonging to heaven. Hence God is not ashamed of them, to be called upon as their God, for he has made a city ready for them. (Hebrews 11:16)
- Women received their dead by resurrection, but other men were tortured because they would not accept release by some ransom, in order, that they might attain a better resurrection. (Hebrews 11:35)
- For, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will gather the captive ones of my people, Israel and Judah, Yehowah has said, and I will bring them back to the land that I gave to their forefathers, and they will certainly repossess it. (Jeremiah 30:3)
- And I will bring them out from the peoples and collect them together from the lands and bring them in onto their soil and feed them

on the mountains of Israel, by the streambeds and by all the dwelling places of the land. (Ezekiel 34:13)

- At that time, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall become God to all the families of Israel, and as for them, they will become my people. (Jeremiah 31:1)
- And the sons of Judah and the sons of Israel will certainly be collected together into a unity and will actually set up for themselves one head and go up out of the land, because great will be the day of Jezreel. (Hosea 1:11)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; I shall certainly return to Jerusalem with mercies. My own house will be built in her, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and a measuring line itself will be stretched out over Jerusalem. (Zechariah 1:16)

- In the coming days Jacob will take root, Israel will put forth blossoms and actually sprout, and they will simply fill the surface of the productive land with produce. (Isaiah 27:6)
- And my anger will certainly come to its finish and I will appease my rage on them and comfort myself, and they will have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have spoken in my insistence on exclusive devotion, when I bring my rage to its finish upon them. (Ezekiel 5:13)
- And the slain one will certainly fall in the midst of You, and You will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 6:7)
- And I will gather back the captive ones of my people Israel, and they will actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (Amos 9:14)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they will feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they will lie stretched out. For Yehowah their God will turn

his attention to them and certainly gather back the captive ones of them. (Zephaniah 2:7)
