Isaiah 12:1... And in that day you will be sure to say; I shall thank you, O Yehowah, for although you got incensed at me, your anger gradually turned back, and you proceeded to comfort me.

[26] - References

- And it will certainly occur in that day that those remaining over of Israel and those who have escaped of the house of Jacob will never again support themselves upon the one striking them, and they will certainly support themselves upon Yehowah, the Holy One of Israel, in trueness. (Isaiah 10:20)
- Speak to the heart of Jerusalem and call out to her that her military service has been fulfilled, that her error has been paid off. For from the hand of Yehowah she has received a full amount for all her sins. (Isaiah 40:2)
- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he will completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She will be rebuilt. And of the temple: You will have your foundation laid. (Isaiah 44:28)
- For that reason my people will know my name, even for that reason in that day, because I am the One that is speaking. Look! It is I. (Isaiah 52:6)
- Like a man whom his own mother keeps comforting, so I myself shall keep comforting you people, and in the case of Jerusalem you will be comforted. (Isaiah 66:13)
- When Yehowah gathered back the captive ones of Zion, we became like those who were dreaming. (Psalms 126:1)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)

- Because being under his anger is for a moment, being under his goodwill is for a lifetime. In the evening weeping may take up lodging, but in the morning there is a joyful cry. (Psalms 30:5)
- You have taken pleasure, O Yehowah, in your land, you have brought back the ones taken captive of Jacob. (Psalms 85:1)
- Come, you people, and do let us return to Yehowah, for he himself has torn in pieces but he will heal us. He kept striking, but he will bind us up. (Hosea 6:1)
- And she would say to the women; Do not call me Naomi. Call me Mara, for the Almighty has made it very bitter for me. (Ruth 1:20)
- According to the days on which the Jews had rested from their enemies and the month that was changed for them from grief to rejoicing and from mourning to a good day, to hold them as days of banqueting and rejoicing and sending of portions to one another and of gifts to the poor people. (Esther 9:22)
- Is it not you, O God, who have cast us off and who do not go forth with our armies as God? (Psalms 60:10)
- You have controlled all your fury, you have turned back from the heat of your anger. (Psalms 85:3)
- And it must occur in the day when Yehowah gives you rest from your pain and from your agitation and from the hard slavery in which you were made a slave. (Isaiah 14:3)
- They themselves will raise their voice, they will cry out joyfully. In the superiority of Yehowah they will certainly cry out shrilly from the sea. (Isaiah 24:14)
- There is no rage that I have. Who will give me thornbushes and weeds in the battle? I will step on such. I will set such on fire at the same time. (Isaiah 27:4)
- Give a glad cry, you heavens, and be joyful, you earth. Let the mountains become cheerful with a glad outcry. For Yehowah has comforted his people, and he shows pity upon his own afflicted ones. (Isaiah 49:13)
- I have seen his very ways, and I began to heal him and conduct him and make compensation with comfort to him and to his mourning ones. (Isaiah 57:18)

- And foreigners will actually build your walls, and their own kings will minister to you, for in my indignation I shall have struck you, but in my goodwill I shall certainly have mercy upon you. (Isaiah 60:10)
- So that anyone blessing himself in the earth will bless himself by the God of faith, and anyone making a sworn statement in the earth will swear by the God of faith, because the former distresses will actually be forgotten and because they will actually be concealed from my eyes. (Isaiah 65:16)
- I shall heal their unfaithfulness. I shall love them of my own free will, because my anger has turned back from him. (Hosea 14:4)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; I shall certainly return to Jerusalem with mercies. My own house will be built in her, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and a measuring line itself will be stretched out over Jerusalem. (Zechariah 1:16)
- And now I shall not be as in the former days to the remaining ones of this people, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (Zechariah 8:11)
