

ALL MEN - I SHALL THANK YOU O YEHOWAH

Isaiah 12:1 And in that day you will be sure to say; I shall thank you, O Yehowah, for although you got incensed at me, your anger gradually turned back, and you proceeded to comfort me.

- And it **will** certainly occur in that day that those remaining over of Israel and those who have escaped of the house of Jacob **will** never again support themselves upon the one striking them, and they **will** certainly support themselves upon **Yehowah**, the Holy One of Israel, in trueness. (**Isaiah 10:20**)
- **SPEAK** to the heart of Jerusalem and call out to her that her military service has been fulfilled, that her error has been paid off. For from the hand of **Yehowah** she has received a full amount for all her sins. (**Isaiah 40:2**)
- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he **will** completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be rebuilt. And of the temple: You **will** have your foundation laid. (**Isaiah 44:28**)
- For that reason my people **will** know my name, even for that reason in that day, because I am the One that is speaking. Look! It is I. (**Isaiah 52:6**)
- Like a man whom his own mother keeps comforting, so I myself shall keep comforting **you** people, and in the case of Jerusalem **you will** be comforted. (**Isaiah 66:13**)
- When **Yehowah** gathered **back** the captive ones of Zion, we became like those who were dreaming. (**Psalms 126:1**)
- **Yehowah** your God must also bring **back** your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where **Yehowah** your God has scattered you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)

- Because being under his **anger** is for a moment, being under his goodwill is for a lifetime. In the evening weeping may take up lodging, but in the morning there is a joyful cry. (**Psalms 30:5**)
- You have taken pleasure, O **Yehowah**, in your land, you have brought **back** the ones taken captive of Jacob. (**Psalms 85:1**)
- Come, **you** people, and do let us return to **Yehowah**, for he himself has torn in pieces but he **will** heal us. He kept striking, but he **will** bind us up. (**Hosea 6:1**)
- And she would **say** to the women; Do not call me Naomi. Call me Mara, for the Almighty has made it very bitter for me. (**Ruth 1:20**)
- According to the **days** on which the Jews had rested from their enemies and the month that was changed for them from grief to rejoicing and from mourning to a good day, to hold them as **days** of banqueting and rejoicing and sending of portions to one another and of gifts to the poor people. (**Esther 9:22**)
- Is it not you, O God, who have cast us off and who do not go forth with our armies as God? (**Psalms 60:10**)
- You have controlled all your fury, you have **turned back** from the heat of your **anger**. (**Psalms 85:3**)
- And it must occur in the day when **Yehowah** gives you rest from your pain and from your agitation and from the hard slavery in which you were made a slave. (**Isaiah 14:3**)
- They themselves **will** raise their voice, they **will** cry out joyfully. In the superiority of **Yehowah** they **will** certainly cry out shrilly from the sea. (**Isaiah 24:14**)
- There is no rage that I have. Who **will** give me thornbushes and weeds in the battle? I **will** step on such. I **will** set such on fire at the same time. (**Isaiah 27:4**)
- Give a glad cry, **you** heavens, and be joyful, you earth. Let the mountains become cheerful with a glad outcry. For **Yehowah** has comforted his people, and he shows pity upon his own afflicted ones. (**Isaiah 49:13**)
- I have seen his very ways, and I began to heal him and conduct him and make compensation with **comfort** to him and to his mourning ones. (**Isaiah 57:18**)

- And foreigners **will** actually build your walls, and their own kings **will** minister to you, for in my indignation I shall have struck you, but in my goodwill I shall certainly have mercy upon you. (**Isaiah 60:10**)
- So that anyone blessing himself in the earth **will** bless himself by the God of faith, and anyone making a sworn statement in the earth **will** swear by the God of faith, because the former distresses **will** actually be forgotten and because they **will** actually be concealed from my eyes. (**Isaiah 65:16**)
- I shall heal their unfaithfulness. I shall love them of my own free **will**, because my **anger** has **turned back** from him. (**Hosea 14:4**)
- Therefore this is what **Yehowah** has said; I shall certainly return to Jerusalem with mercies. My own house **will** be built in her, is the utterance of **Yehowah** of armies, and a measuring line itself **will** be stretched out over Jerusalem. (**Zechariah 1:16**)
- And now I shall not be as in the former **days** to the remaining ones of this people, is the utterance of **Yehowah** of armies. (**Zechariah 8:11**)
- Happy are those who mourn, since they **will** be comforted. (**Matthew 5:4**)
- Saying; We **thank** you, **Yehowah** God, the Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and begun ruling as king. (**Revelation 11:17**)
