- But as for the rest of the beasts, their rulerships were taken away, and there was a lengthening in life given to them for a time and a season. (**Daniel 7:12**)
- And the ten horns that you saw mean ten **kings**, who have not yet received a **kingdom**, but they do receive authority as **kings** one hour with the wild beast. (**Revelation 17:12**)
- This is what Cyrus the king of Persia has said; All the **kingdoms** of the earth Yehowah the **God** of the **heavens** has given me, and he himself has commissioned me to build him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. (**Ezra 1:2**)
- But our **God** is in the **heavens**, everything that he delighted to do he has done. (**Psalms 115:3**)
- As regards the **heavens**, to Yehowah the **heavens** belong, but the earth he has given to the sons of men. (**Psalms 115:16**)
- The scepter **will** not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him the obedience of the **peoples will** belong. (**Genesis 49:10**)

- And he **will** plant his palatial tents between the grand sea and the holy mountain of Decoration, and he **will** have to come all the way to his **end**, and there **will** be no helper for him. (**Daniel 11:45**)

- And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he **will** shepherd them with a rod of

iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of **God** the Almighty. (**Revelation 19:15**)

- How grand his signs are, and how mighty his wonders are! His **kingdom** is a **kingdom** to time **indefinite**, and his rulership is for generation after generation. (**Daniel 4:3**)

- And at the **end** of the days I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted up to the **heavens** my eyes, and my own understanding began to return to me, and I blessed the Most High himself, and the One living to time **indefinite** I praised and glorified, because his rulership is a rulership to time **indefinite** and his **kingdom** is for generation after generation. - Let **peoples** serve you and let national groups bow low to you. Become master over your brothers, and let the sons of your mother bow low to you. Cursed be each one of those cursing you, and blessed be each one of those blessing you. (**Genesis 27:29**)

- **God** is bringing him out of Egypt, The swift course of a wild bull is his. He **will** consume the nations, his oppressors, and their bones he **will** gnaw, and he **will** break them to pieces with his arrows. (**Numbers 24:8**)

- And your house and your **kingdom will** certainly be steadfast to time **indefinite** before you, your very throne **will** become one firmly established to time **indefinite**. (**2 Samuel 7:16**)

- He is the one that **will** build me a house, and I shall certainly establish his throne firmly to time **indefinite**. (**1 Chronicles 17:12**)

- And I **will** cause him to **stand** in my house and in my kingship to time **indefinite**, and his throne **will** itself become one lasting to time **indefinite**. (**1 Chronicles 17:14**)

- That which is made crooked cannot be made straight, and that which is wanting cannot possibly be counted. (**Ecclesiastes 1:15**)

- And upon all the lofty mountains and upon all the hills that are lifted up. (**Isaiah 2:14**)

• And in loving-kindness a throne **will** certainly be firmly established, and one must sit down upon it in trueness in the tent of David, judging and seeking justice and being prompt in righteousness. (**Isaiah 16:5**)

• All the nations are as something nonexistent in front of him, as nothing and an unreality they have been accounted to him. (**Isaiah 40:17**)

• But to whom can **you people** liken me so that I should be made his equal? says the Holy One. (**Isaiah 40:25**)

• Who has roused up someone from the sunrise? Who proceeded in righteousness to call him to His feet, to give before him the nations, and to make him go subduing even **kings**? Who kept giving them like dust to his sword, so that they have been driven about like mere stubble with his bow? (**Isaiah 41:2**)

• Look! I have made you a threshing sledge, a new threshing instrument having double-edged teeth. You **will** tread down the mountains and **crush** them, and the hills you **will** make just like the chaff. (**Isaiah 41:15**)

• And I **will** make all my mountains a way, and my highways themselves **will** be on an elevation. (**Isaiah 49:11**)

• Therefore say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; There **will** be no postponement anymore as to any words of mine. What word I shall speak, it **will** even be done, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 12:28**)

• For a day is near, yes, a day belonging to Yehowah is near. A day of clouds, an appointed time of nations it **will** prove to be. (**Ezekiel 30:3**)

• And I **will** raise up over them one shepherd, and he must feed them, even my servant David. He himself **will** feed them, and he himself **will** become their shepherd. (**Ezekiel 34:23**)

• You kept on looking until a stone was cut out not by hands, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and of molded clay and crushed them. (**Daniel 2:34**)

times indefinite, and his kingdom is one that will not be brought to ruin, and his dominion is forever. (Daniel 6:26)

- And I shall certainly overthrow the throne of kingdoms and annihilate the strength of the kingdoms of the nations, and I will overthrow the chariot and its riders, and the horses and their riders will certainly come down, each one by the sword of his brother. (Haggai 2:22)

- Also, the person falling upon this stone will be shattered. As for anyone upon whom it falls, it will pulverize him. (Matthew 21:44)

- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)

- And cure the sick ones in it, and go on telling them, the kingdom of God has come near to you. (Luke 10:9)

- Then he said to them; Whenever you pray, say; Father, let your name be sanctified. Let your kingdom come. (Luke 11:2)

- Everyone falling upon that stone will be shattered. As for anyone upon whom it falls, it will pulverize him. (Luke 20:18)

- Next, the end, when he hands over the kingdom to his God and Father, when he has brought to nothing all government and all authority and power. (1 Corinthians 15:24)

- This manifestation the happy and only Potentate will show in its own appointed times, he the King of those who rule as kings and Lord of those who rule as lords. (1 Timothy 6:15)
