Daniel 12:10. Many will cleanse themselves and whiten themselves and will be refined. And the wicked ones will certainly act wickedly, and no wicked ones at all will understand, but the ones having insight will understand.

[26] - References

- May you purify me from sin with hyssop, that I may be clean,
 may you wash me, that I may become whiter even than snow. (Psalms 51:7)
- And I will sprinkle upon you clean water, and you will become clean, from all your impurities and from all your dungy idols I shall cleanse you. (Ezekiel 36:25)
- Come, now, you people, and let us set matters straight between us, says Yehowah. Though the sins of you people should prove to be as scarlet, they will be made white just like snow, though they should be red like crimson cloth, they will become even like wool. (Isaiah 1:18)
- So right away I said to him; My lord, you are the one that knows. And he said to me; These are the ones that come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. (Revelation 7:14)
- And some of those having insight will be made to stumble, in order to do a refining work because of them and to do a cleansing and to do a whitening, until the time of the end, because it is yet for the time appointed. (Daniel 11:35)
- And he must sit as a refiner and cleanser of silver and must cleanse the sons of Levi, and he must clarify them like gold and like silver, and they will certainly become to Yehowah people presenting a gift offering in righteousness. (Malachi 3:3)

- For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, self-assuming, haughty, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, disloyal. (2 Timothy 3:2)
- But wicked men and impostors will advance from bad to worse,
 misleading and being misled. (2 Timothy 3:13)
- Because the senseless one himself will speak mere senselessness, and his very heart will work at what is hurtful, to work at apostasy and to speak against Yehowah what is wayward, to cause the soul of the hungry one to go empty, and he causes even the thirsty one to go without drink itself. (Isaiah 32:6)
- Who is wise, that he may understand these things? Discreet, that he may know them? For the ways of Yehowah are upright, and the righteous are the ones who will walk in them, but the transgressors are the ones who will stumble in them. (Hosea 14:9)
- The fear of Yehowah is the beginning of wisdom. All those doing them have a good insight. His praise is standing forever. (Psalms 111:10)
- And so find favor and good insight in the eyes of God and of earthling man. (Proverbs 3:4)
- And as regards those having insight among the people, they will impart understanding to the many. And they will certainly be made to stumble by sword and by flame, by captivity and by plundering, for some days. (Daniel 11:33)
- And the ones having insight will shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who are bringing the many to righteousness, like the stars to time indefinite, even forever. (Daniel 12:3)
- But we know that the Son of God has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity that we may gain the knowledge of the true one. And we are in union with the true one, by means of his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and life everlasting. (1 John 5:20)
- With the one keeping clean you will show yourself clean, and with the crooked one you will show yourself tortuous. (Psalms 18:26)
- No unreasoning man himself can know them, and no one stupid can understand this. (Psalms 92:6)
- Your people will offer themselves willingly on the day of your military force. In the splendors of holiness, from the womb of the

dawn, you have your company of young men just like dewdrops. (Psalms 110:3)

- The righteousness of your reminders is to time indefinite. Make me understand, that I may keep living. (Psalms 119:144)
- A man, even a stranger, is crooked in his way, but the pure one is upright in his activity. (Proverbs 21:8)
- I shall not hold an accounting against YOUR daughters because they commit fornication, and against YOUR daughters-in-law because they commit adultery. For, as to the men, it is with the harlots that they get off to themselves, and with the female temple prostitutes that they sacrifice, and a people that does not understand will be trodden down. (Hosea 4:14)
- But who will be putting up with the day of his coming, and who will be the one standing when he appears? For he will be like the fire of a refiner and like the lye of laundrymen. (Malachi 3:2)
