

## NATIONS - THE NATIONAL GROUPS WILL MAKE A DIN

**Isaiah 17:13**· The national groups themselves will make a din just like the noise of many waters. And He will certainly rebuke it, and it must flee far away and be chased like the chaff of the mountains before a wind and like a thistle whirl before a storm wind.

- Why have the nations been in tumult and the national **groups** themselves kept muttering an empty thing? (**Psalms 2:1**)
- You have rebuked nations, you have destroyed the wicked one. Their name you have wiped out to time indefinite, even forever. (**Psalms 9:5**)
- May they become like **chaff before the wind**, and let Yehowah's angel be pushing them along. (**Psalms 35:5**)
- Let national **groups** rejoice and cry out joyfully, for you **will** judge the peoples with uprightness, and as for national **groups**, on the earth you **will** lead them. (**Psalms 67:4**)
- O my God, **make** them like a **thistle whirl**, like stubble **before a wind**. (**Psalms 83:13**)
- Listen! A crowd in the **mountains**, something like a numerous people! Listen! The uproar of kingdoms, of nations gathered together! Yehowah of armies is mustering the army of war. (**Isaiah 13:4**)
- At the sound of turmoil peoples have fled. At your arising nations have been dispersed. (**Isaiah 33:3**)
- And the crowd of those strange to you **must** become **just** like fine powder, and the crowd of the tyrants **just** like the **chaff** that is passing **away**. And it **must** occur in an instant, suddenly. (**Isaiah 29:5**)
- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the **chaff** from the

summer threshing floor, and the **wind** carried them **away** so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (**Daniel 2:35**)

- Therefore they **will** become like the clouds of morning and like the dew that early goes **away**, like **chaff** that is stormed **away** from the threshing floor and like smoke from the roof hole. (**Hosea 13:3**)

- Do they become like straw **before** a **wind**, and like **chaff** that a **storm wind** has stolen **away**? (**Job 21:18**)

- The wicked are not like that, but are like the **chaff** that the **wind** drives **away**. (**Psalms 1:4**)

- I would hasten to a place of escape for me from the rushing **wind**, from the tempest. (**Psalms 55:8**)

- **You** people conceive dried grass, **you will** give birth to stubble. **YOUR** own spirit, as a fire, **will** eat **you** up. (**Isaiah 33:11**)

- Look! The nations are as a drop from a bucket, and as the film of dust on the scales they have been accounted. Look! He lifts the islands themselves as mere fine dust. (**Isaiah 40:15**)

- You **will** winnow them, and a **wind** itself **will** carry them **away**, and a windstorm itself **will** drive them different ways. And you yourself **will** be joyful in Yehowah. In the Holy One of Israel you **will** boast about yourself. (**Isaiah 41:16**)

- And the second angel blew his trumpet. And something like a great mountain burning with fire was hurled into the sea. And a third of the sea became blood. (**Revelation 8:8**)
