~ **New Jerusalem** ... **Prophecy** ... **Pretty For Loftiness** - the exultation of the whole earth, the town of the grand king (Psalms 48:2) [27] - References

Psalms 48:2... Pretty for loftiness, the exultation of the whole earth, is Mount Zion on the remote sides of the north, the town of the grand King.

- Out of **Zion**, the perfection of prettiness, God himself has beamed forth. (Psalms 50:2)
- At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept wagging their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the city of which they used to say; It is the perfection of prettiness, an **exultation** for all the **earth**? (Lamentations 2:15)
- As for you, you have said in your heart; To the heavens I shall go up. Above the stars of God I shall lift up my throne, and I shall sit down upon the mountain of meeting, in the remotest parts of the **north**. (Isaiah 14:13)
- God has become king over the nations. God himself has taken his seat upon his holy throne. (Psalms 47:8)
- Blessed out of **Zion** be Yehowah, who is residing in Jerusalem. Praise Yah, **you** people! (Psalms 135:21)
- Nor by **earth**, because it is the footstool of his feet, nor by Jerusalem, because it is the city of the great **King**. (Matthew 5:35)
- And the inhabitants of Jebus began to say to David; You will not come in here. Just the same, David proceeded to capture the stronghold of **Zion**, that is to say, the City of David. (1 Chronicles 11:5)
- And **King** Rehoboam continued to make his position strong in Jerusalem and kept reigning, for Rehoboam was forty-one years old when he began to reign, and for seventeen years he reigned in

Jerusalem, the city that Yehowah had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel to put his name there. And his mother's name was Naamah the Ammonitess. (**2 Chronicles 12:13**)

- Raise **YOUR** heads, O **YOU** gates, and raise yourselves up, O **YOU** long-lasting entrances, that the glorious **King** may come in! (**Psalms 24:7**)
- O my God, within me my very soul is in despair. That is why I remember you, from the land of Jordan and the peaks of Hermon, from the little mountain. (**Psalms 42:6**)
- Why do **YOU**, O **YOU** mountains of peaks, keep watching enviously the mountain that God has desired for himself to dwell in? Even Yehowah himself will reside there forever. (**Psalms 68:16**)
- Remember your assembly that you acquired long ago, the tribe that you redeemed as your inheritance, this **Mount Zion** in which you have resided. (**Psalms 74:2**)
- Glorious things are being spoken about you, O city of the true God. (**Psalms 87:3**)
- Every morning I shall silence all the wicked ones of the **earth**, to cut off from the city of Yehowah all the practicers of what is hurtful. A prayer of the afflicted in case he grows feeble and pours out his concern before Yehowah himself. (**Psalms 101:8**)
- Jerusalem is one that is built like a city that has been joined together in oneness. (**Psalms 122:3**)
- Those trusting in Yehowah are like **Mount Zion**, which cannot be made to totter, but dwells even to time indefinite. (**Psalms 125:1**)
- You are beautiful, O girl companion of mine, like Pleasant City, comely like Jerusalem, awesome as companies gathered around banners. (**Song of Solomon 6:4**)
- O how the faithful **town** has become a prostitute! She was full of justice, righteousness itself used to lodge in her, but now murderers. (**Isaiah 1:21**)
- In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah; We have a strong city. He sets salvation itself for walls and rampart. (**Isaiah 26:1**)
- And to you the sons of those afflicting you must go, bowing down, and all those treating you disrespectfully must bend down at the

very soles of your feet, and they will have to call you the city of Yehowah, **Zion** of the Holy One of Israel. (**Isaiah 60:14**)

- And you must become a crown of beauty in the hand of Yehowah, and a kingly turban in the palm of your God. (**Isaiah 62:3**)

- And you kept decking yourself with gold and silver, and your attire was fine linen and costly material and an embroidered garment. Fine flour and honey and oil were what you ate, and you grew to be very, very pretty, and gradually you became fit for royal position. (**Ezekiel 16:13**)

- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands. (**Ezekiel 20:6**)

- And out of one of them there came forth another horn, a small one, and it kept getting very much greater toward the south and toward the sunrising and toward the Decoration. (**Daniel 8:9**)

- O Yehowah, according to all your acts of righteousness, please, may your anger and your rage turn back from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain, for, because of our sins and because of the errors of our forefathers, Jerusalem and your people are an object of reproach to all those round about us. (**Daniel 9:16**)

- And the one coming against him will do according to his will, and there will be no one standing before him. And he will stand in the land of the Decoration, and there will be extermination in his hand. (**Daniel 11:16**)

- He will also actually enter into the land of the Decoration, and there will be many lands that will be made to stumble. But these are the ones that will escape out of his hand, Edom and Moab and the main part of the sons of Ammon. (**Daniel 11:41**)
