- Return, **YOU** renegade **sons**. I shall heal **YOUR** renegade condition. Here we are! We have **come** to you, for you, O **Yehowah**, are our **God**. (**Jeremiah 3:22**)
- In those **days** and at that time, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, the **sons** of **Israel**, they and the **sons** of Judah together, **will come**. They **will** walk, weeping as they walk, and for **Yehowah** their **God** they **will** seek. (**Jeremiah 50:4**)

- This one **will** be great and **will** be called Son of the Most High, and **Yehowah God will** give him the throne of **David** his father. (**Luke 1:32**)
- And he said to me; These words are faithful and true, yes, **Yehowah** the **God** of the inspired expressions of the prophets sent his angel forth to show his slaves the things that must shortly take place. (**Revelation 22:6**)
- For there is the true forgiveness with you, in order, that you may be feared. (**Psalms 130:4**)
- And she **will certainly** become to me a name of exultation, a praise and a beauty toward all the nations of the earth who **will** hear of all the **goodness** that I am rendering to them. And they **will certainly** be in dread and be agitated on account of all the **goodness** and on account of all the peace that I am rendering to her. (**Jeremiah 33:9**)

- And you have returned to **Yehowah** your **God** and listened to his voice according to all that I am commanding you today, you and your **sons**, with all your heart and all your soul. (**Deuteronomy 30:2**)
- Fear **Yehowah**, **you** holy ones of his, for there is no lack to those fearing him. (**Psalms 34:9**)
- I have concluded a covenant toward my chosen one, I have sworn to **David** my servant. (**Psalms 89:3**)
- For when he sees his children, the work of my hands, in the midst of him, they **will** sanctify my name, and they **will certainly** sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and the **God** of **Israel** they **will** regard with awe. (**Isaiah 29:23**)
- To Zion they **will** keep asking the way, with their faces in that direction, saying; Come and let us join ourselves to **Yehowah** in an indefinitely lasting covenant that **will** not be forgotten. (**Jeremiah 50:5**)
