- For, on account of **David**, Yehowah his God gave him a lamp in Jerusalem by raising his son up after him and keeping Jerusalem in existence. (**1 Kings 15:4**)
- And I shall **certainly defend** this **city** to **save** it for my **own sake** and for the **sake** of **David** my servant. (**2 Kings 19:34**)
- And I shall **certainly** add fifteen years to your days, and out of the palm of the king of Assyria I shall deliver you and this **city**, and I will **defend** this **city** for my **own sake** and for the **sake** of **David** my servant. (**2 Kings 20:6**)
- Like birds flying, Yehowah of armies will in the same way **defend** Jerusalem. Defending her, he will also **certainly** deliver her. Sparing her, he must also cause her to escape. (**Isaiah 31:5**)
- And out of the palm of the king of Assyria I shall deliver you and this **city**, and I will **defend** this **city**. (**Isaiah 38:6**)
- Were it not that I was afraid of vexation from the enemy, that their adversaries might misconstrue it, that they might say; Our hand has proved superior, and it was not Yehowah who worked all this out. (**Deuteronomy 32:27**)
- For Yehowah will not desert his people for the **sake** of his great name, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to make **you** his people. (**1 Samuel 12:22**)
- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Not for **your sakes** am I doing it, O house of Israel, but for my holy name, which **you** have profaned among the nations where **you** have come in. (**Ezekiel 36:22**)

- And my servant **David** will be king over them, and one shepherd is what they will all come to have, and in my judicial decisions they will walk, and my statutes they will keep, and they will **certainly** carry them out. (**Ezekiel 37:24**)
- And they will **certainly** serve Yehowah their God and **David** their king, whom I shall raise up for them. (**Jeremiah 30:9**)
- Yehowah will also **certainly** create over every established place of Mount Zion and over her convention place a cloud by day and a smoke, and the brightness of a flaming fire by night, because over all the glory there will be a shelter. (**Isaiah 4:5**)
- And it must occur in that day that his load will depart from upon your shoulder, and his yoke from upon your neck, and the yoke will **certainly** be wrecked because of the oil. (**Isaiah 10:27**)
