~ Messianic · Prophecy · New Order - And I will set among them a sign, and I will send some of the remnant to faraway lands where they have not heard a report about my glory, for they will certainly tell about my glory among the nations · (Isaiah 66:19) [26] - References

Isaiah 66:19. And I will set among them a sign, and I will send some of those who are escaped to the nations, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, those drawing the bow, Tubal and Javan, the faraway islands, who have not heard a report about me or seen my glory, and they will for certain tell about my glory among the nations.

[26] - References

- Whoever there is among You of all his people, may his God prove to be with him. So let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and rebuild the house of Yehowah the God of Israel, he is the true God, which was in Jerusalem. (Ezra 1:3)
- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he will completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She will be rebuilt. And of the temple: You will have your foundation laid. (Isaiah 44:28)
- For the eager expectation of the creation is waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. (Romans 8:19)
- And I saw thrones, and there were those who sat down on them, and power of judging was given them. Yes, I saw the souls of those executed with the ax for the witness they bore to Jesus and for speaking about God, and those who had worshiped neither the wild beast nor its image and who had not received the mark upon their forehead and upon their hand. And they came to life and ruled as kings with the Christ for a thousand years. (Revelation 20:4)
- The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection. (Revelation 20:5)
- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because you sold me here, because for the preservation of life God has sent me ahead of you. (Genesis 45:5)

- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there will be no plowing time or harvest. (Genesis 45:6)
- Consequently God sent me ahead of you in order to place a remnant for you men in the earth and to keep you alive by a great escape. (Genesis 45:7)
- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (Matthew 28:18)
- Go therefore and make disciples of people of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19)
- Teaching them to observe all the things I have commanded you. And, look! I am with you all the days until the conclusion of the system of things. (Matthew 28:20)
- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)
- In that day what Yehowah makes sprout will come to be for decoration and for glory, and the fruitage of the land will be something to be proud of and something beautiful for those of Israel who have escaped. (Isaiah 4:2)
- And he will send forth his angels with a great trumpet sound, and they will gather his chosen ones together from the four winds, from one extremity of the heavens to their other extremity. (Matthew 24:31)
- Listen to me, O you islands, and pay attention, you national groups far away. Yehowah himself has called me even from the belly. From the inward parts of my mother he has made mention of my name. (Isaiah 49:1)
- For from the sun's rising even to its setting my name will be great among the nations, and in every place sacrificial smoke will be made, a presentation will be made to my name, even a clean gift, because my name will be great among the nations, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 1:11)
- And nations will certainly go to your light, and kings to the brightness of your shining forth. (Isaiah 60:3)

- And again Isaiah says: There will be the root of Jesse, and there will be one arising to rule nations, on him nations will rest their hope. (Romans 15:12)
- After these things I saw, and, look! A great crowd, which no man was able to number, out of all nations and tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, dressed in white robes, and there were palm branches in their hands. (Revelation 7:9)
- The sons of Japheth were Gomer and Magog and Madai and Javan and Tubal and Meshech and Tiras. (Genesis 10:2)
- The sons of Japheth were Gomer and Magog and Madai and Javan and Tubal and Meshech and Tiras. (1 Chronicles 1:5)
- Declare among the nations his glory, among all the peoples his wonderful works. (Psalms 96:3)
- And it must occur in that day that Yehowah will again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the remnant of his people who will remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (Isaiah 11:11)
- A thousand will tremble on account of the rebuke of one, on account of the rebuke of five you will flee until you will have remained over like a mast on the top of a mountain and like a signal on a hill. (Isaiah 30:17)
- Let them attribute to Yehowah glory, and in the islands let them tell forth even his praise. (Isaiah 42:12)
- Instead of the thicket of thorns the juniper tree will come up. Instead of the stinging nettle the myrtle tree will come up. And it must become for Yehowah something famous, a sign to time indefinite that will not be cut off. (Isaiah 55:13)
- Go up, O you horses, and drive madly, O you chariots! And let the mighty men go forth, Cush and Put, who are handling the shield, and the Ludim, who are handling and treading the bow. (Jeremiah 46:9)
- Javan, Tubal and Meshech themselves were your traders. For the souls of mankind and articles of copper your articles of exchange were given. (Ezekiel 27:13)

- Son of man, set your face against Gog of the land of Magog, the head chieftain of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him. (Ezekiel 38:2)
- And now what is truth I shall tell to you; Look! There will yet be three kings standing up for Persia, and the fourth one will amass greater riches than all others. And as soon as he has become strong in his riches, he will rouse up everything against the kingdom of Greece. (Daniel 11:2)
- And it must occur that, as regards everyone who is left remaining out of all the nations that are coming against Jerusalem, they must also go up from year to year to bow down to the King, Yehowah of armies, and to celebrate the festival of the booths. (Zechariah 14:16)
