- And he **will** wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death **will** be no more, neither **will** mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away. (**Revelation 21:4**)
- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** conclude with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah a New Covenant. (**Jeremiah 31:31**)

For I shall forgive their **error**, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)

- And Yehowah **will** certainly remove from you every sickness, and as for all the evil diseases of Egypt that you have known, he **will** not

place them upon you, and he **will** indeed put them upon all those who hate you. (**Deuteronomy 7:15**)
