NEW ORDER - NOT BY MY FORCE OR BY POWER, BUT BY MY SPIRIT

Zechariah 4:6" Accordingly he answered and said to me; This is the word of Yehowah to Zerubbabel, saying; Not by a military force, nor by power, but by my spirit, Yehowah of armies has said.

- So I shall indeed let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, and he will certainly chase after them and I shall get glory for myself by means of Pharaoh and all his military forces, and the Egyptians will certainly know that I am Yehowah. Accordingly they did just that. (Exodus 14:4)
- The One bringing forth the war chariot and the horse, the military force and the strong ones at the same time; They will lie down. They will not get up. They will certainly be extinguished. Like a flaxen wick they must be put out. (Isaiah 43:17)
- In turn David said to the Philistine; You are coming to me with a sword and with a spear and with a javelin, but I am coming to you with the name of Yehowah of armies, the God of the battle lines of Israel, whom you have taunted. (1 Samuel 17:45)
- But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I will save them by Yehowah their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (Hosea 1:7)
- And, on the other hand, I myself have become full of power, with the spirit of Yehowah, and of justice and mightiness, in order to tell to Jacob his revolt and to Israel his sin. (Micah 3:8)
- And Yehowah's spirit enveloped Gideon so that he went blowing the horn, and the Abi-ezrites got to be called together after him. (Judges 6:34)
- He, for his part, came as far as Lehi, and the Philistines, for their part, shouted exultantly at meeting him. And Yehowah's spirit became operative upon him, and the ropes that were upon his arms came to be

like linen threads that have been scorched with fire, so that his fetters melted off his hands. (Judges 15:14)

- Just as when a beast itself goes down into the valley plain, the very spirit of Yehowah proceeded to make them rest. Thus you led your people in order to make a beautiful name for your own self. (Isaiah 63:14)
- Namely, Jesus who was from Nazareth, how God anointed him with Holy Spirit and power, and he went through the land doing good and healing all those oppressed by the Devil, because God was with him. (Acts of Apostles 10:38)
- Yehowah's spirit now came upon Jephthah, and he proceeded to pass through Gilead and Manasseh and to pass through Mizpeh of Gilead, and from Mizpeh of Gilead he passed along to the sons of Ammon. (Judges 11:29)
- Then Yehowah's spirit became operative upon him, so that he tore it in two, just as someone tears a male kid in two, and there was nothing at all in his hand. And he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done. (Judges 14:6)
- However, Samson kept lying till midnight and then rose at midnight and grabbed hold of the doors of the city gate and the two side posts and pulled them out along with the bar and put them upon his shoulders and went carrying them up to the top of the mountain that is in front of Hebron. (Judges 16:3)
- So they went from there to the hill, and here there was a group of prophets to meet him, at once the spirit of God became operative upon him, and he began to speak as a prophet in the middle of them. (1 Samuel 10:10)
- And it happened on the day of battle that not a sword or a spear was found in the hand of any of the people that were with Saul and Jonathan, but there could be found one belonging to Saul and to Jonathan his son. (1 Samuel 13:22)
- Then David girded his sword on over his garments and undertook to go but could not, because he had not tried them out. Finally David said to Saul; I am unable to go in these things, for I have not tried them out. So David removed them off him. (1 Samuel 17:39)
- And all this congregation will know that neither with sword nor with spear does Yehowah save, because to Yehowah belongs the battle, and he must give you men into our hand. (1 Samuel 17:47)

- And Malchiram and Pedaiah and Shenazzar, Jekamiah, Hoshama and Nedabiah. (1 Chronicles 3:18)
- And Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the grandson of Iddo the prophet prophesied to the Jews who were in Judah and in Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel who was over them. (Ezra 5:1)
- For I felt ashamed to ask a military force and horsemen from the king to help us against the enemy in the way, because we had said to the king; The hand of our God is over all those seeking him for good, but his strength and his anger are against all those leaving him. (Ezra 8:22)
- And from the sunset they will begin to fear the name of Yehowah, and from the rising of the sun the glory of him, for he will come in like a distressing river, which the very spirit of Yehowah has driven along. (Isaiah 59:19)
- And one began to remember the days of long ago, Moses his servant; Where is the One that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherds of his flock? Where is the One that put within him His own Holy Spirit? (Isaiah 63:11)
- And Yehowah proceeded to rouse up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, the governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak the High Priest, and the spirit of all the remaining ones of the people, and they began to enter in and to do the work in the house of Yehowah of armies their God. (Haggai 1:14)
- Remember the thing that I concluded with you people when you came forth from Egypt, and when my spirit was standing in among you. Do not be afraid. (Haggai 2:5)
- For the word of God is alive and exerts power and is sharper than any two-edged sword and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, and of joints and their marrow, and is able to discern thoughts and intentions of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)
