- Man, born of woman, is short-lived and glutted with agitation. (**Job 14:1**)
- Like a **blossom** he **has** come forth and is cut off, and he runs away like the shadow and does not keep existing. (**Job 14:2**)
- For a thousand years are in your eyes but as yesterday when it is past, and as a watch during the night. (**Psalms 90:4**)
- You have swept them away, they become a mere sleep, in the morning they are just like **green grass** that changes. (**Psalms 90:5**)
- In the morning it puts forth **blossoms** and must change, at evening it withers and certainly dries up. (**Psalms 90:6**)
- For we have come to an end in your anger, and by your rage we have been disturbed. (**Psalms 90:7**)
- For the sun rises with its burning heat and withers the vegetation, and its flower drops off and the beauty of its outward appearance perishes. So, too, the rich man will fade away in his ways of life. (**James 1:11**)
- As for mortal man, his days are like those of **green grass**, like a **blossom** of the field is the way he **blossoms** forth. (**Psalms 103:15**)
- For a mere wind **has** to pass over it, and it is no more, and its place will acknowledge it no further. (**Psalms 103:16**)

- If you conceal your face, they get disturbed. If you take away their **spirit**, they expire, and back to their dust they go. (**Psalms 104:29**)
- And their inhabitants will be feeble-handed, they will simply be terrified and will be ashamed. They must become as vegetation of the field and **green** tender **grass**, **grass** of the roofs, when there is a scorching before the east wind. (**2 Kings 19:26**)
- My heart **has** been struck just like vegetation and is **dried** up, for I have forgotten to eat my food. (**Psalms 102:4**)
- My days are like a shadow that **has** declined, and I myself am **dried** up like mere vegetation. (**Psalms 102:11**)
- For a mere wind **has** to pass over it, and it is no more, and its place will acknowledge it no further. (**Psalms 103:16**)
- And their inhabitants will be feeble-handed, they will simply be terrified and ashamed. They must become as vegetation of the field and **green** tender **grass**, **grass** of the roofs and of the terrace before the east wind. (**Isaiah 37:27**)
