Isaiah 35:5... At that time the eyes of the blind ones will be opened, and the very ears of the deaf ones will be unstopped.

[14] - References

- Yehowah is opening the eyes of the blind ones, Yehowah is raising up the ones bowed down, Yehowah is loving the righteous ones. (Psalms 146:8)
- And I will make the blind ones walk in a way that they have not known, in a roadway that they have not known I shall cause them to tread. I shall turn a dark place before them into light, and rugged terrain into level land. These are the things that I will do for them, and I will not leave them. (Isaiah 42:16)
- And their eyes received sight. Moreover, Jesus sternly charged them, saying; See that nobody gets to know it. (Matthew 9:30)
- And in that day the deaf ones will certainly hear the words of the book, and out of the gloom and out of the darkness even the eyes of the blind ones will see. (Isaiah 29:18)
- To whom shall I speak and give warning, that they may hear? Look! Their ear is uncircumcised, so that they are unable to pay attention. Look! The very word of Yehowah has become to them a reproach, in which word they can take no delight. (Jeremiah 6:10)
- Well, his hearing powers were opened, and the impediment of his tongue was loosed, and he began speaking normally. (Mark 7:35)
- Hence in answer he said to the two; Go YOUR way, report to John what YOU saw and heard. The blind are receiving sight, the lame are walking, the lepers are being cleansed and the deaf are hearing, the dead are being raised up, the poor are being told the Good News. (Luke 7:22)
- And happy is he who has not stumbled over me. (Luke 7:23)

- For you to open the blind eyes, to bring forth out of the dungeon the prisoner, out of the house of detention those sitting in darkness. (Isaiah 42:7)
- The blind are seeing again, and the lame are walking about, the lepers are being cleansed and the deaf are hearing, and the dead are being raised up, and the poor are having the Good News declared to them. (Matthew 11:5)
- Then great crowds approached him, having along with them people that were lame, maimed, blind, dumb, and many otherwise, and they fairly threw them at his feet, and he cured them. (Matthew 15:30)
- Indeed, they were being astounded in a most extraordinary way and they said; He has done all things well. He even makes the deaf hear and the speechless speak. (Mark 7:37)
