You people will come to have a song like that in the night that one sanctifies oneself for a festival, and rejoicing of heart like that of one walking with a flute to enter into the mountain of Yehowah, to the Rock of Israel.

[17] - References

- You will winnow them, and a wind itself will carry them away, and a windstorm itself will drive them different ways. And you yourself will be joyful in Yehowah. In the Holy One of Israel you will boast about yourself. (Isaiah 41:16)
- At that time Moses and the sons of Israel proceeded to sing this song to Yehowah and to say the following; Let me sing to Yehowah, for he has become highly exalted the horse and its rider he has pitched into the sea. (Exodus 15:1)
- So they came to Jerusalem with stringed instruments and with harps and with trumpets to the house of Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 20:28)
- The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; LAUD Yehowah of armies, for Yehowah is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness! They will be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of Yehowah, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 33:11)
- And you must rejoice during your festival, you and your son and your daughter and your man slave and your slave girl and the Levite and the alien resident and the fatherless boy and the widow, who are inside your gates. (Deuteronomy 16:14)
- These things I will remember, and I will pour out my soul within me. For I used to pass along with the throng, I used to walk slowly

before them to the house of God, with the voice of a joyful cry and thanksgiving, of a crowd celebrating a festival. (Psalms 42:4)

- Strike up a melody and take a tambourine, the pleasant harp together with the stringed instrument. (Psalms 81:2)
- Finally, after singing praises, they went out to the Mount of Olives. (Matthew 26:30)
- And David and all Israel were celebrating before the true God with full power and with songs and with harps and with stringed instruments and with tambourines and with cymbals and with trumpets. (1 Chronicles 13:8)
- Praise him with the tambourine and the circle dance. Praise him with strings and the pipe. (Psalms 150:4)
- For who is a God besides Yehowah? And who is a rock except our God? (Psalms 18:31)
- O come let us cry out joyfully to Yehowah! Let us shout in triumph to our Rock of salvation. (Psalms 95:1)
- And many peoples will certainly go and say; Come, you people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)
- Trust in Yehowah, you people, for all times, for in Yah, Yehowah is the Rock of times indefinite. (Isaiah 26:4)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)
- After that all the people came on up following him, and the people were playing on flutes and rejoicing with great joy, so that the earth was split by the noise of them. (1 Kings 1:40)
