Isaiah 14:13... As for you, you have said in your heart, To the heavens I shall go up. Above the stars of God I shall lift up my throne, and I shall sit down upon the mountain of meeting, in the remotest parts of the north. [22] - References

- This he caused to abound toward us in all wisdom and good sense. (Ephesians 1:8)
- In that he made known to us the sacred secret of his will. It is according to his good pleasure which he purposed in himself (Ephesians 1:9)
- For an administration at the full limit of the appointed times, namely, to gather all things together again in the Christ, the things in the heavens and the things on the earth. Yes, in him. (Ephesians 1:10)

- Pretty for loftiness, the exultation of the whole earth, is Mount Zion on the remote sides of the north, the town of the grand King. (Psalms 48:2)
- Whom have you taunted and spoken of abusively? And against whom have you lifted up your voice and do you raise your eyes on high? It is against the Holy One of Israel! (2 Kings 19:22)
- Although his excellency ascends to heaven itself And his very head reaches to the clouds. (Job 20:6)

- Summon against Babylon archers, all who are treading the bow. Encamp against her all around. May there prove to be no escapees. Pay back to her according to her activity. According to all that she has done, do to her. For it is against Yehowah that she has acted presumptuously, against the Holy One of Israel. (Jeremiah 50:29)
