Son of Man, set your face against Pharaoh the king of Egypt and prophesy against him and against Egypt in its entirety.

[12] - References

- And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)
- And Cush became father to Nimrod. He made the start in becoming a mighty one in the earth. (Genesis 10:8)
- He displayed himself a mighty hunter in opposition to Yehowah. That is why there is a saying; Just like Nimrod a mighty hunter in opposition to Yehowah. (Genesis 10:9)
- And the beginning of his kingdom came to be Babel and Erech and Accad and Calneh, in the land of Shinar. (Genesis 10:10)
- Out of that land he went forth into Assyria and set himself to building Nineveh and RehobothIr and Calah (Genesis 10:11)
- And Resen between Nineveh and Calah, this is the great city. (Genesis 10:12)
- But the thing was bad in the eyes of Samuel inasmuch as they had said; Do give us a king to judge us, and Samuel began to pray to Yehowah. (1 Samuel 8:6)
- Then Yehowah said to Samuel; Listen to the voice of the people as respects all that they say to you, for it is not you whom they have rejected, but it is I whom they have rejected from being king over them. (1 Samuel 8:7)
- In accord with all their doings that they have done from the day of my bringing them up out of Egypt until this day in that they kept leaving me and serving other gods, that is the way they are doing also to you. (1 Samuel 8:8)

- And now listen to their voice. Only this, that you should solemnly warn them, and you must tell them the rightful due of the king who will reign over them. (1 Samuel 8:9)
- Whom have you come to resemble thus in glory and greatness among the trees of Eden? But you will certainly be brought down with the trees of Eden to the land down below. In the midst of the uncircumcised ones you will lie down with those slain by the sword. This is Pharaoh and all his crowd, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 31:18)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am giving Pharaoh Hophra, the king of Egypt, into the hand of his enemies and into the hand of those seeking for his soul, just as I have given Zedekiah the king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, his enemy and the one seeking for his soul. (Jeremiah 44:30)
- The pronouncement against Egypt; Look! Yehowah is riding on a swift cloud and coming into Egypt. And the valueless gods of Egypt will certainly quiver because of him, and the very heart of Egypt will melt in the midst of it. (Isaiah 19:1)
- Pharaoh the king of Egypt and his servants and his princes and all his people. (Jeremiah 25:19)
- And he must come in and strike the land of Egypt. Whoever is due for deadly plague will be for deadly plague, and whoever is due for captivity will be for captivity, and whoever is due for the sword will be for the sword. (Jeremiah 43:11)
- Son of man, say to Pharaoh the king of Egypt and to his crowd, Whom have you come to resemble in your greatness? (Ezekiel 31:2)
- Upon Egypt and upon Judah and upon Edom and upon the sons of Ammon and upon Moab and upon all those with hair clipped at the temples who are dwelling in the wilderness, for all the nations are uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel are uncircumcised in heart. (Jeremiah 9:26)
- For Egypt, concerning the military force of Pharaoh Necho the king of Egypt, who happened to be by the river Euphrates at Carchemish, whom Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon defeated in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, the king of Judah. (Jeremiah 46:2)
- In that day messengers will go forth from before me in the ships, in order to drive self-confident Ethiopia into trembling. And severe

pains must occur among them in the day of Egypt, for, look! it must come. (Ezekiel 30:9)
