- Saying; I, **even** I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (**Psalms 2:6**)
- You make him dominate over the works of your hands, everything you have put under his feet. (**Psalms 8:6**)
- Also, I myself shall place him as firstborn, the most high of the kings of the earth. (**Psalms 89:27**)
- The rod of your strength Yehowah **will** send out of Zion, saying; Go subduing in the midst of your enemies. (**Psalms 110:2**)
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule **will** come to be upon his shoulder. His name **will** be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (**Isaiah 9:6**)
- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (**Matthew 28:18**)
- All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and who the Son is no one knows but the Father, and who the Father is, no one knows but the Son, and he to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (**Luke 10:22**)
- For he must rule as king until God has put all enemies under his feet (**1 Corinthians 15:25**)

- He also subjected all things under his feet, and made him head over all things to the congregation. (**Ephesians 1:22**)
- To the one that conquers I **will** grant to sit down with me on my throne, **even** as I conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne. (**Revelation 3:21**)
- For this very reason also God exalted him to a superior position and kindly gave him the name that is above every other name. (**Philippians 2:9**)
- The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand. (**John 3:35**)
- The scepter **will** not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him the obedience of the **peoples will** belong. (**Genesis 49:10**)
- God is your throne to time indefinite, **even** forever, the scepter of your kingship is a scepter of uprightness. (**Psalms 45:6**)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there **will** be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his **kingdom** in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies **will** do this. (**Isaiah 9:7**)
- And in the days of those kings the God of heaven **will** set up a **kingdom** that **will** never be **brought** to **ruin**. And the **kingdom** itself **will** not be passed on to any other people. It **will** crush and put an end to all these **kingdoms**, and it itself **will** stand to times indefinite. (**Daniel 2:44**)
- And he **will** rule as king over the house of Jacob forever, and there **will** be no end of his **kingdom**. (**Luke 1:33**)
- And the seventh angel blew his trumpet. And loud voices occurred in heaven, saying; The **kingdom** of the world did become the **kingdom** of our Lord and of his Christ, and he **will** rule as king forever and ever. (**Revelation 11:15**)
- His glory is great in your salvation. Dignity and splendor you put upon him. (**Psalms 21:5**)
- His seed itself **will** prove to be **even** to time indefinite, and his throne as the sun in front of me. (**Psalms 89:36**)

- And Yehowah of armies **will** certainly make for all the **peoples**, in this mountain, a banquet of well-oiled dishes, a banquet of wine kept on the dregs, of well-oiled dishes filled with marrow, of wine kept on the dregs, filtered. (**Isaiah 25:6**)
- Look! As a witness to the **national groups** I have given him, as a leader and commander to the **national groups**. (**Isaiah 55:4**)
- Likewise could my own covenant be broken with David my servant so that he should not come to have a son ruling as king upon his throne, also with the Levites, the priests, my ministers. (**Jeremiah 33:21**)
- A **ruin**, a **ruin**, a **ruin** I shall make it. As for this also, it **will** certainly become no one's until he comes who has the legal right, and I must give it to him. (**Ezekiel 21:27**)
- You kept on looking until a stone was cut out not by hands, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and of molded clay and crushed them. (**Daniel 2:34**)
- And you they **will** be driving **away** from men, and with the beasts of the field your dwelling **will** come to be, and the vegetation is what they **will** give **even** to you to eat just like bulls, and with the dew of the heavens you yourself **will** be getting wet, and seven times themselves **will pass** over you, until you know that the Most High is Ruler in the **kingdom** of mankind, and that to the one whom he wants to he gives it. (**Daniel 4:25**)
- Jesus said to them; Truly I say to **you**; In the re-creation, when the Son of man sits down upon his glorious throne, **you** who have followed me **will** also yourselves sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. (**Matthew 19:28**)
- And then the sign of the Son of man **will** appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth **will** beat themselves in lamentation, and they **will** see the Son of man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (**Matthew 24:30**)
- Jesus said to him; You yourself said it. Yet I say to **you** men, From henceforth **you will** see the Son of man sitting at the right hand of power and coming on the clouds of heaven. (**Matthew 26:64**)
- Then he said to them; Whenever **you** pray, say, Father, let your name be sanctified. Let your **kingdom** come. (**Luke 11:2**)

- According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life. (**John 17:2**)
- Jesus answered; My **kingdom** is no part of this world. If my **kingdom** were part of this world, my attendants would have fought that I should not be delivered up to the Jews. But, as it is, my **kingdom** is not from this source. (**John 18:36**)
- He sent out the word to the sons of Israel to declare to them the Good News of peace through Jesus Christ, this One is Lord of all others. (**Acts of Apostles 10:36**)
- This manifestation the happy and only Potentate **will** show in its own appointed times, he the King of those who rule as kings and Lord of those who rule as lords. (**1 Timothy 6:15**)
- But we behold Jesus, who has been made a little lower than angels, crowned with glory and honor for having suffered death, that he by God's undeserved kindness might taste death for every man. (**Hebrews 2:9**)
- For he received from God the Father honor and glory, when words such as these were borne to him by the magnificent glory; This is my son, my beloved, whom I myself have approved. (**2 Peter 1:17**)
- Consequently we have the prophetic word made more sure, and **you** are doing well in paying attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until day dawns and a daystar rises, in **your** hearts. (**2 Peter 1:19**)
- And I saw, and, look! A white horse, and the one seated upon it had a bow, and a crown was given him, and he went forth conquering and to complete his conquest. (**Revelation 6:2**)
