Ezekiel 37:9.. And he went on saying to me; Prophecy to the wind. Prophecy, O Son of Man, and you must say to the wind; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; From the four winds come in, O wind, and blow upon these killed people, that they may come to life.

- As for me, shall I cause the breaking through and not cause the giving birth, says Yehowah? Or am I causing a giving birth and do I actually cause a shutting up? your God **has said**. (**Isaiah 66:9**)
- For just as the new heavens and the new earth that I am making are standing before me, is the utterance of Yehowah, so the offspring of **you people** and the name of **you people** will keep standing. (**Isaiah 66:22**)
- Most truly I **say** to **you**, the hour is coming, and it is now, when the dead will hear the voice of the **Son** of God and those who have given heed will live. (**John 5:25**)
- For just as the Father **has life** in himself, so he **has** granted also to the **Son** to have **life** in himself. (**John 5:26**)
- And he **has** given him authority to do judging, because **Son** of man he is. (**John 5:27**)
- Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice (**John 5:28**)
- And **come** out, those who did good things to a resurrection of **life**, those who practiced vile things to a resurrection of judgment. (**John 5:29**)
- See **what** sort of love the Father **has** given us, so that we should be called children of God, and such we are. That is why the world does

not have a knowledge of us, because it **has** not **come** to know him. (1 John 3:1)

- Beloved ones, now we are children of God, but as yet it **has** not been made manifest **what** we shall be. We do know that whenever he is made manifest we shall be like him, because we shall see him just as he is. (1 John 3:2)

- And everyone who **has** this hope set upon him purifies himself just as that one is pure. (1 John 3:3)

- Everyone who practices sin is also practicing Lawlessness, and so sin is Lawlessness. (1 John 3:4)

- **You** know too that that one was made manifest to take away our sins, and there is no sin in him. (1 John 3:5)

- Everyone remaining in union with him does not practice sin, no one that practices sin **has** either seen him or **come** to know him. (1 John 3:6)

- Little children, let no one mislead **you**, he who carries on righteousness is righteous, just as that one is righteous. (1 John 3:7)

- He who carries on sin originates with the Devil, because the Devil **has** been sinning from the beginning. For this purpose the **Son** of God was made manifest, namely, to break up the works of the Devil. (1 John 3:8)

- For here I am creating new heavens and a new earth, and the former things will not be called to mind, neither will they **come** up into the heart. (Isaiah 65:17)

- But exult, **you people**, and be joyful forever in **what** I am creating. For here I am creating Jerusalem a cause for joyfulness and her **people** a cause for exultation. (Isaiah 65:18)

- And I will be joyful in Jerusalem and exult in my **people**, and no more will there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (Isaiah 65:19)

- And I shall put my words in your mouth, and with the shadow of my hand I shall certainly cover you, in order to plant the heavens and lay the foundation of the earth and **say** to Zion, You are my **people**. (Isaiah 51:16)

- Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will by no means pass away. (Matthew 24:35)

- And I saw a great white throne and the one seated on it. From before him the earth and the heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. (**Revelation 20:11**)
- And I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the former heaven and the former earth had passed away, and the sea is no more. (**Revelation 21:1**)
- I saw also the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (**Revelation 21:2**)
- If you send forth your spirit, they are created, and you make the face of the ground new. (**Psalms 104:30**)
- This is **what** the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah **has said** to these bones; Here I am bringing into **you** breath, and **you must come** to **life**. (**Ezekiel 37:5**)
