- Therefore everyone that hears these sayings of mine and does them **will** be likened to a discreet man, who built his house upon the rock-mass. (**Matthew 7:24**)
- And the rain poured down and the **floods** came and the winds blew and lashed against that house, but it did not cave in, for it had been founded upon the rock-mass. (**Matthew 7:25**)
- Furthermore, everyone hearing these sayings of mine and not doing them **will** be likened to a foolish man, who built his house upon the sand. (**Matthew 7:26**)
- And the rain poured down and the **floods** came and the winds blew and struck against that house and it caved in, and its collapse was great. (**Matthew 7:27**)
- And I shall certainly stretch upon Jerusalem the **measuring line** applied to Samaria and also the **leveling instrument** applied to the house of Ahab, and I shall simply wipe Jerusalem clean just as one wipes the handleless bowl clean, wiping it clean and turning it upside down. (**2 Kings 21:13**)
- And he himself **will** judge the productive land in **righteousness**, he **will** judicially try national groups in uprightness. (**Psalms 9:8**)
- Judge me according to your **righteousness**, O Yehowah my God, and may they not rejoice over me. (**Psalms 35:24**)

- But Yehowah of armies is judging with **righteousness**, he is examining the kidneys and the heart. O may I see your vengeance on them, for it is to you that I have revealed my case at Law. (**Jeremiah 11:20**)
- Look! Yehowah has someone strong and vigorous. Like a thunderous storm of **hail**, a destructive storm, like a thunderous storm of powerful, flooding **waters**, he **will** certainly do a casting down to the earth with force. (**Isaiah 28:2**)
- Now, look! You have put your trust in the support of this crushed reed, Egypt, which, if a man should brace himself upon it, would certainly enter into his palm and pierce it. That is the way Pharaoh the king of Egypt is to all those putting their trust in him. (**2 Kings 18:21**)
- Woe to those going down to Egypt for assistance, those who rely on mere horses, and who put their trust in war chariots, because they are numerous, and in steeds, because they are very mighty, but who have not looked to the Holy One of Israel and have not searched for Yehowah himself. (**Isaiah 31:1**)
- The Egyptians, though, are earthling men, and not God, and their horses are flesh, and not spirit. And Yehowah himself **will** stretch **out** his hand, and he that is offering help **will** have to stumble, and he that is being helped **will** have to fall, and at the same time they **will** all of them come to an end. (**Isaiah 31:3**)
- I, I am Yehowah, and besides me there is no savior. (**Isaiah 43:11**)
- Saying; No, but into the land of Egypt we shall enter, where we shall see no war and the sound of the horn we shall not hear and for bread we shall not go hungry, and there is where we shall dwell. (**Jeremiah 42:14**)
- And they finally came into the land of Egypt, for they did not obey the voice of Yehowah, and they came gradually as far as Tahpanhes. (**Jeremiah 43:7**)
- But he finally rebelled against him in sending his messengers to Egypt, for it to give him horses and a multitudinous people. Will he have success? Will he escape, he who is doing these things, and who has broken a covenant? And **will** he actually escape? (**Ezekiel 17:15**)
- For the reason, yes, for the reason that they have led my people astray, saying, There is peace! When there is no peace. And there is

one that is building a partition wall, but in vain there are those plastering it with whitewash. (Ezekiel 13:10)

- Say to those plastering with whitewash that it **will** fall. A flooding downpour **will** certainly occur, and **you**, O hailstones, **will** fall, and a blast of windstorms itself **will** cause a splitting. (Ezekiel 13:11)
- And, look! The wall **must** fall. Will it not be said to **you** men, Where is the coating with which **you** did the plastering? (Ezekiel 13:12)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I **will** also cause a blast of windstorms to burst forth in my rage, and in my anger there **will** occur a flooding downpour, and in rage there **will** be hailstones for an extermination. (Ezekiel 13:13)
- And I **will** tear down the wall that **you** men have plastered with whitewash and bring it into contact with the earth, and its foundation **must** be exposed. And she **will** certainly fall, and **you must** come to an end in the midst of her, and **you will** have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 13:14)
- And I **will** bring my rage to its finish upon the wall and upon those plastering it with whitewash, and I shall say to **you** men; The wall is no more, and those plastering it are no more. (Ezekiel 13:15)
