- Tell it in Judah, you men, and publish it even in Jerusalem, and say it out, and blow a horn throughout the land. Call out loudly and say; Gather yourselves together, and let us enter into the fortified cities. (Jeremiah 4:5)
- And he really sees the sword coming upon the land and blows the horn and warns the people. (Ezekiel 33:3)
- A day of horn and of alarm signal, against the fortified cities and against the high corner towers. (Zephaniah 1:16)
- This is what Yehowah has said; I will return to Zion and reside in the midst of Jerusalem, and Jerusalem will certainly be called the city of trueness, and the mountain of Yehowah of armies, the holy mountain. (Zechariah 8:3)
- If a horn is blown in a city, do not also the people themselves tremble? If a calamity occurs in the city, is it not also Yehowah who has acted? (Amos 3:6)
- The great day of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the day of Yehowah is bitter. There a mighty man is letting out a cry. (Zephaniah 1:14)
- For, look! The day is coming that is burning like the furnace, and all the presumptuous ones and all those doing wickedness must become as stubble. And the day that is coming will certainly devour them, Yehowah of armies has said, so that it will not leave to them either root or bough. (Malachi 4:1)

- And it came about that when he got there he began blowing the horn in the mountainous region of Ephraim, and the sons of Israel began going down with him out of the mountainous region, he being at their head. (Judges 3:27)
- All you inhabitants of the productive land and you residents of the earth, you will see a sight just as when there is the raising up of a signal upon the mountains, and you will hear a sound just as when there is the blowing of a horn. (Isaiah 18:3)

- BLOW a horn in Gibeah, a trumpet in Ramah! SHOUT a war cry at Beth-aven, after you, O Benjamin! (Hosea 5:8)

- Blow a horn in Zion, O men. Sanctify a time of fasting. Call together a solemn assembly. (Joel 2:15)
