- I will also collect together all the nations and bring them down to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, and I will put myself on judgment with them there on account of my people and my inheritance Israel, whom they scattered among the nations, and they apportioned out my own land.

- Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my denunciation, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the earth will be devoured. (Zephaniah 3:8)
- And I shall certainly gather all the nations against Jerusalem for the war, and the city will actually be captured and the houses be pillaged, and the women themselves will be raped. And half of the city must go forth into the exile, but as for the remaining ones of the people, they will not be cut off from the city. (Zechariah 14:2)
- And they gathered them together to the place that is called in Hebrew Har-Magedon. (Revelation 16:16)
- Let the nations be aroused and come up to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, for there I shall sit in order to judge all the nations round about. (Joel 3:12)
- For as fire Yehowah himself will for a fact take up the controversy, yes, with his sword, against all flesh, and the slain of Yehowah will certainly become many. (Isaiah 66:16)
- And I will bring myself into judgment with him, with pestilence and with blood, and a flooding downpour and hailstones, fire and

sulphur I shall rain down upon him and upon his bands and upon the many peoples that will be with him. (Ezekiel 38:22)

- This is what Yehowah has said against all my bad neighbors, who are touching the hereditary possession that I caused my people, even Israel, to possess; Here I am uprooting them from off their ground, and the house of Judah I shall uproot from the midst of them. (Jeremiah 12:14)
- By reason of your saying; These two nations and these two lands, they will become my own, and we shall certainly take possession of each land, whereas Yehowah himself happened to be right there. (Ezekiel 35:10)
- I have heard the reproach by Moab and the abusive words of the sons of Ammon, with which they have reproached my people and kept putting on great airs against their territory. (Zephaniah 2:8)
- A noise will certainly come clear to the farthest part of the earth, for there is a controversy that Yehowah has with the nations. He must personally put himself in judgment with all flesh. As regards the wicked ones, he must give them to the sword, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 25:31)
- And this is what will prove to be the scourge with which Yehowah will scourge all the peoples that will actually do military service against Jerusalem; There will be a rotting away of one's flesh, while one is standing upon one's feet, and one's very eyes will rot away in their sockets, and one's very tongue will rot away in one's mouth. (Zechariah 14:12)
