- And back and forth the earth began to shake and to rock, the foundations of the heavens themselves became agitated, and they kept shaking back and forth because he had been angered. (2 Samuel 22:8)
- The earth itself rocked, heaven itself also dripped because of God, this Sinai rocked because of God, the God of Israel. (Psalms 68:8)
- The mountains themselves proceeded to melt just like wax on account of Yehowah, on account of the Lord of the whole earth. (Psalms 97:5)
- At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, saying; Yet once more I will set in commotion not only the earth but also the heaven. (Hebrews 12:26)
- His lightnings lighted up the productive land, the earth saw and came to be in severe pains. (Psalms 97:4)
- Look! Yehowah is emptying the land and laying it waste, and he has twisted the face of it and scattered its inhabitants. (Isaiah 24:1)
- Then a trembling occurred in the camp in the field and among all the people of the outpost, and the force of pillagers trembled, even they, and the earth began quaking, and it developed into a trembling from God. (1 Samuel 14:15)
- But it said; Go out, and you must stand on the mountain before Yehowah. And, look! Yehowah was passing by, and a great and strong wind was rending mountains and breaking crags before Yehowah.

- O mountains, that you went skipping about like rams, O hills, like lambs? (Psalms 114:6)
- That is why the anger of Yehowah has grown hot against his people, and he will stretch out his hand against them and strike them. And the mountains will be agitated, and their dead bodies will become like the offal in the midst of the streets. In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 5:25)
- I saw the mountains, and, look! They were rocking, and the hills themselves were all given a shaking. (Jeremiah 4:24)
- But Yehowah is in truth God. He is the living God and the King to time indefinite. Because of his indignation the earth will rock, and no nations will hold up under his denunciation. (Jeremiah 10:10)
- And because of me the fish of the sea and the flying creatures of the heavens and the wild beasts of the field and all the creeping things that are creeping on the ground and all mankind that are upon the surface of the ground will be bound to shiver, and the mountains will actually be thrown down and the steep ways will have to fall, and to the earth even every wall will fall. (Ezekiel 38:20)
