Isaiah 35:4... Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! Your own God will come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself will come and save you people.

## [26] - References

• This takes into account that it is righteous on God's part to repay tribulation to those who make tribulation for YOU. (2 Thessalonians 1:6)

But, to you who suffer tribulation, relief along with us at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with his powerful angels (2 Thessalonians 1:7)

In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)

• These very ones will undergo the judicial punishment of everlasting destruction from before the Lord and from the glory of his strength. (2 Thessalonians 1:9)

• At the time he comes to be glorified in connection with his holy ones and to be regarded in that day with wonder in connection with all those who exercised faith, because the witness we gave met with faith among You. (2 Thessalonians 1:10)

• And they cried with a loud voice, saying; Until when, Sovereign Lord holy and true, are you refraining from judging and avenging our blood upon those who dwell on the earth? (Revelation 6:10)

• And in that day one will certainly say; Look! This is our God. We have hoped in him, and he will save us. This is Yehowah. We have hoped in him. Let us be joyful and rejoice in the salvation by him. (Isaiah 25:9)

• But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I will save them by Yehowah their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (Hosea 1:7)

• She will give birth to a son, and you must call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. (Matthew 1:21)

• Anxious care in the heart of a man is what will cause it to bow down, but the good word is what makes it rejoice. (Proverbs 12:25)

• Then he said; Do not be afraid, O very desirable man. May you have peace. Be strong, yes, be strong. And as soon as he spoke with me I exerted my strength and finally said; Let my lord speak, because you have strengthened me. (Daniel 10:19)

But now be strong, O Zerubbabel, is the utterance of Yehowah, and be strong, O Joshua the son of Jehozadak the High Priest. And be strong, all you people of the land, is the utterance of Yehowah, and work. For I am with you people, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies (Haggai 2:4)

• Finally, go on acquiring power in the Lord and in the mightiness of his strength. (Ephesians 6:10)

• Whatever day I get afraid, I, for my part, shall trust even in you. (Psalms 56:3)

• In that day it will be said to Jerusalem; Do not be afraid, O Zion. May your hands not drop down. (Zephaniah 3:16)

• And do not become fearful of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, but rather be in fear of him that can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. (Matthew 10:28)

• But my righteous one will live by reason of faith, and, if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him. (Hebrews 10:38)

• Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot will move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (Deuteronomy 32:35)

Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but yield place to the wrath, for it is written; Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says Yehowah. (Romans 12:19)

• For there must come upon her, upon Babylon, the despoiler, and her mighty men will certainly be captured. Their bows must be

shattered, for Yehowah is a God of recompenses. Without fail he will repay. (Jeremiah 51:56)

• And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)

• And he must say to them, Hear, O Israel, YOU are drawing near today to the battle against YOUR enemies. Do not let YOUR hearts be timid. Do not be afraid and run in panic or shudder because of them. (Deuteronomy 20:3)

• Be courageous, and may YOUR heart be strong, all YOU who are waiting for Yehowah. (Psalms 31:24)

• O God of acts of vengeance, Yehowah, O God of acts of vengeance, beam forth! (Psalms 94:1)

• For Yehowah has a day of vengeance, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (Isaiah 34:8)

• For the day of vengeance is in my heart, and the very year of my repurchased ones has come. (Isaiah 63:4)

• Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am stretching out my hand against the Philistines, and I will cut off the Cherethites and destroy the rest of the seacoast. (Ezekiel 25:16)

• And he went on to say to me; Do not be afraid, O Daniel, for from the first day that you gave your heart to understanding and humbling yourself before your God your words have been heard, and I myself have come because of your words. (Daniel 10:12)

This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Let the hands of you people be strong, you who are hearing in these days these words from the mouth of the prophets, on the day on which the foundation of the house of Yehowah of armies was laid, for the temple to be built. (Zechariah 8:9)
