~ **Messianic** ... **Prophecy** ... **Yehowah's Day** - Say to those anxious at heart, be strong, Yehowah will come with vengeance itself and a repayment, he himself will save you people. **(Isaiah 35:4)** [\[26\] - References](#)

Isaiah 35:4 Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! **YOUR** own God will come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself will come and save **YOU** people.

- This takes into account that it is righteous on God's part to repay tribulation to those who make tribulation for **you**. **(2 Thessalonians 1:6)**
- But, to **you** who suffer tribulation, relief along with us at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with his powerful angels **(2 Thessalonians 1:7)**
- In a flaming fire, as he brings **vengeance** upon those who do not know **God** and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. **(2 Thessalonians 1:8)**
- These very ones **will** undergo the judicial punishment of everlasting destruction from before the Lord and from the glory of his strength. **(2 Thessalonians 1:9)**
- At the time he **comes** to be glorified in connection with his holy ones and to be regarded in that day with wonder in connection with all those who exercised faith, because the witness we gave met with faith among **you**. **(2 Thessalonians 1:10)**
- And they cried with a loud voice, saying; Until when, Sovereign Lord holy and true, are you refraining from judging and avenging our blood upon those who dwell on the earth? **(Revelation 6:10)**
- And in that day one **will** certainly say; Look! This is our **God**. We have hoped in him, and he **will save** us. This is Yehowah. We have hoped in him. Let us be joyful and rejoice in the salvation by him. **(Isaiah 25:9)**

- But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I **will save** them by Yehowah their **God**, but I shall not **save** them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (**Hosea 1:7**)
- She **will** give birth to a son, and you must call his name Jesus, for he **will save** his people from their sins. (**Matthew 1:21**)
- Anxious care in the **heart** of a man is what **will** cause it to bow down, but the good word is what makes it rejoice. (**Proverbs 12:25**)
- Then he said; Do not be **afraid**, O very desirable man. May you have peace. Be **strong**, yes, be strong. And as soon as he spoke with me I exerted my strength and finally said; Let my lord speak, because you have strengthened me. (**Daniel 10:19**)
- But now be **strong**, O Zerubbabel, is the utterance of Yehowah, and be **strong**, O Joshua the son of Jehozadak the High Priest. And be **strong**, all **you** people of the land, is the utterance of Yehowah, and work. For I am with **you** people, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies (**Haggai 2:4**)
- Finally, go on acquiring power in the Lord and in the mightiness of his strength. (**Ephesians 6:10**)
- Whatever day I get **afraid**, I, for my part, shall trust **even** in you. (**Psalms 56:3**)
- In that day it **will** be said to Jerusalem; Do not be **afraid**, O Zion. May your hands not drop down. (**Zephaniah 3:16**)
- And do not become fearful of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, but rather be in fear of him that can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. (**Matthew 10:28**)
- But my righteous one **will** live by reason of faith, and, if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him. (**Hebrews 10:38**)
- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot **will** move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (**Deuteronomy 32:35**)
- Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but yield place to the wrath, for it is written; Vengeance is mine, I **will** repay, says Yehowah. (**Romans 12:19**)
- For there must **come** upon her, upon Babylon, the despoiler, and her mighty men **will** certainly be captured. Their bows must be

shattered, for Yehowah is a **God** of recompenses. Without fail he **will** repay. (**Jeremiah 51:56**)

- And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He **will** bruise you in the head and you **will** bruise him in the heel. (**Genesis 3:15**)

- And he must say to them, Hear, O Israel, **you** are drawing near today to the battle against **your** enemies. Do not let **your** **hearts** be timid. Do not be **afraid** and run in panic or shudder because of them. (**Deuteronomy 20:3**)

- Be courageous, and may **your** **heart** be **strong**, all **you** who are waiting for Yehowah. (**Psalms 31:24**)

- O **God** of acts of **vengeance**, Yehowah, O **God** of acts of **vengeance**, beam forth! (**Psalms 94:1**)

- For Yehowah has a day of **vengeance**, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (**Isaiah 34:8**)

- For the day of **vengeance** is in my **heart**, and the very year of my repurchased ones has **come**. (**Isaiah 63:4**)

- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am stretching out my hand against the Philistines, and I **will** cut off the Cherethites and destroy the rest of the seacoast. (**Ezekiel 25:16**)

- And he went on to say to me; Do not be **afraid**, O Daniel, for from the first day that you gave your **heart** to understanding and humbling yourself before your **God** your words have been heard, and I myself have **come** because of your words. (**Daniel 10:12**)

- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Let the hands of **you** people be **strong**, **you** who are hearing in these days these words from the mouth of the prophets, on the day on which the foundation of the house of Yehowah of armies was laid, for the temple to be built. (**Zechariah 8:9**)

- And it must occur that just as **you** became a malediction among the nations, O house of Judah and house of Israel, so I shall **save** **you**, and **you** must become a blessing. Do not be **afraid**. May **your** hands be strong. (**Zechariah 8:13**)
