- Search for Yehowah and his strength. Seek his face constantly. (Psalms 105:4)
- And many peoples will certainly go and say; Come, You people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)
- Search for Yehowah, you people, while he may be found. Call to him while he proves to be near. (Isaiah 55:6)
- Search for Yehowah, and keep living, that he may not become operative just like fire, O house of Joseph, and it may not actually devour, and Bethel may not be with no one to extinguish it. (Amos 5:6)
- He will cause the meek ones to walk in his judicial decision, and he will teach the meek ones his way. (Psalms 25:9)
- When God rose up to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. (Psalms 76:9)
- Happy are the mild-tempered ones, since they will inherit the earth. (Matthew 5:5)
- Keep on, then, seeking first the kingdom and his righteousness, and all these other things will be added to you. (Matthew 6:33)

- For in it God's righteousness is being revealed by reason of faith and toward faith, just as it is written: But the righteous one, by means of faith he will live. (Romans 1:17)
- For, because of not knowing the righteousness of God but seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. (Romans 10:3)
- And should put on the new personality which was created according to God's will in true righteousness and loyalty. (Ephesians 4:24)
- He will cause the meek ones to walk in his judicial decision, and he will teach the meek ones his way. (Psalms 25:9)
- In you our fathers trusted, they trusted, and you kept providing them with escape. (Psalms 22:4)
- But the meek ones themselves will possess the earth, and they will indeed find their exquisite delight in the abundance of peace. (Psalms 37:11)
- Who is there knowing whether he will turn back and actually feel regret and let remain after it a blessing, a grain offering and a drink offering for Yehowah YOUR God? (Joel 2:14)
- Hate what is bad, and love what is good, and give justice a place in the gate. It may be that Yehowah the God of armies will show favor to the remaining ones of Joseph. (Amos 5:15)
- Who is there knowing whether the true God may turn back and actually feel regret and turn back from his burning anger, so that we may not perish? (Jonah 3:9)
- And those going in, male and female of every sort of flesh, went in, just as God had commanded him. After that Yehowah shut the door behind him. (Genesis 7:16)
- Go, my people, enter into your interior rooms, and shut your doors behind you. Hide yourself for but a moment until the denunciation passes over. (Isaiah 26:20)
- Search after Yehowah and his strength, seek his face constantly.

- Further, he said to Judah to search for Yehowah the God of their forefathers and to do the Law and the commandment. (2 Chronicles 14:4)

- The meek ones will eat and be satisfied, those seeking him will praise Yehowah. May your hearts live forever. (Psalms 22:26)
- For he will hide me in his covert in the day of calamity, he will conceal me in the secret place of his tent, high on a rock he will put me. (Psalms 27:5)
- Concerning you my heart has said; Seek to find my face, you people. Your face, O Yehowah, I shall seek to find. (Psalms 27:8)
- Fill their faces with dishonor, that people may search for your name, O Yehowah. (Psalms 83:16)
- Say, you men, that it will be well with the righteous one, for they will eat the very fruitage of their dealings. (Isaiah 3:10)
- And the meek ones will certainly increase their rejoicing in Yehowah himself, and even the poor ones of mankind will be joyful in the Holy One of Israel himself. (Isaiah 29:19)
- This is what Yehowah has said, the Holy One of Israel and the Former of him; Ask me even about the things that are coming concerning my sons, and concerning the activity of my hands you people should command me. (Isaiah 45:11)
- Listen to me, you people who are pursuing after righteousness, you who are seeking to find Yehowah. Look to the rock from which you were hewn out, and to the hollow of the pit from which you were dug out. (Isaiah 51:1)
- For that reason my people will know my name, even for that reason in that day, because I am the One that is speaking. Look! It is I. (Isaiah 52:6)
- The wine trough I have trodden by myself, while there was no man with me from the peoples. And I kept treading them in my anger, and I kept trampling them down in my rage. And their spurting blood kept spattering upon my garments, and all my clothing I have polluted. (Isaiah 63:3)
- We have for a long time become as those over whom you did not rule, as those upon whom your name had not been called. (Isaiah 63:19)
- You have met up with the one exulting and doing righteousness, those who keep remembering you in your own ways. Look! You yourself became indignant, while we kept sinning, in them a long time, and should we be saved? (Isaiah 64:5)

- Good is Yehowah to the one hoping in him, to the soul that keeps seeking for him. (Lamentations 3:25)
- Even were Noah, Daniel and Job in the midst of it, as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, neither son nor daughter would they deliver, they themselves because of their righteousness would deliver their soul. (Ezekiel 14:20)
