YEHOWAH'S DAY - THE DAY IS COMING THAT IS BURNING LIKE A

Messianic ··· Prophecy ··· Yehowah's Day - The day is coming that is burning like a furnace which will consume like stubble all the presumptuous ones and those doing wickedness, the day will devour them all and leave for them neither root not bough, they will be uprooted and destroyed (Malachi 4:1) [26] - References

Malachi 4:1" For, look! The day is coming that is burning like the furnace, and all the presumptuous ones and all those doing wickedness must become as stubble. And the day that is coming will certainly devour them, Yehowah of armies has said, so that it will not leave to them either root or bough.

[26] - References

- You will constitute them as a fiery furnace at the appointed time for your attention. Yehowah in his anger will swallow them up, and the fire will devour them. (Psalms 21:9)
- Before the statute gives birth to anything, before the day has passed by just like chaff, before there comes upon you people the burning anger of Yehowah, before there comes upon you the day of Yehowah's anger. (Zephaniah 2:2)
- And they will pitch them into the fiery furnace. There is where their weeping and the gnashing of their teeth will be. (Matthew 13:42)
- In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)
- But by the same word the heavens and the earth that are now are stored up for fire and are being reserved to the day of judgment and of destruction of the ungodly men. (2 Peter 3:7)
- And in the abundance of your superiority you can throw down those who rise up against you, You send out your burning anger, it eats them up like stubble. (Exodus 15:7)
- Therefore just as a tongue of fire eats up the stubble and into the flames mere dried grass sinks down, their very rootstock will become just like a musty smell, and their blossom itself will go up just like

powder, because they have rejected the Law of Yehowah of armies, and the saying of the Holy One of Israel they have disrespected. (Isaiah 5:24)

- And the house of Jacob must become a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau as stubble, and they must set them ablaze and devour them. And there will prove to be no survivor to the house of Esau, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (Obadiah 1:18)
- His winnowing shovel is in his hand, and he will completely clean up his threshing floor, and will gather his wheat into the storehouse, but the chaff he will burn up with fire that cannot be put out. (Matthew 3:12)
- Ephraim must be struck down. Their very root must dry up.
 There will be no fruit that they produce. Also, in case they bring to birth, I will even put to death the desirable things of their belly. (Hosea 9:16)
- But as for me, I had annihilated the Amorite on account of them, whose height was like the height of cedars, and who was vigorous like the massive trees, and I went annihilating his fruitage above and his roots below. (Amos 2:9)
- Like a fire that burns up the forest and like a flame that scorches the mountains. (Psalms 83:14)
- Before him a very fire goes, and it consumes his adversaries all around. (Psalms 97:3)
- You have rebuked the cursed presumptuous ones, who are straying from your commandments. (Psalms 119:21)
- And the vigorous man will certainly become tow, and the product of his activity a spark, and both of them will certainly go up in flames at the same time, with no one to do the extinguishing. (Isaiah 1:31)
- The haughty eyes of earthling man must become low, and the loftiness of men must bow down, and Yehowah alone must be put on high in that day. (Isaiah 2:11)
- For wickedness has become aflame just like a fire, thornbushes and weeds it will eat up. And it will catch fire in the thickets of the forest, and they will be borne aloft as the billowing of smoke. (Isaiah 9:18)

- For, look! Yehowah is coming forth from his place to call to account the error of the inhabitant of the land against him, and the land will certainly expose her bloodshed and will no longer cover over her killed ones. (Isaiah 26:21)
- You people conceive dried grass, you will give birth to stubble. Your own spirit, as a fire, will eat you up. (Isaiah 33:11)
- Look! They have become like stubble. A fire itself will certainly burn them up. They will not deliver their soul from the power of the flame. There will be no glow of charcoals for people to warm themselves, no firelight in front of which to sit down. (Isaiah 47:14)
- Look! When it happens to be intact, it is not used for any work. How much less so, when fire itself has devoured it and it gets scorched, can it actually be used for any further work! (Ezekiel 15:5)
- And a sword will certainly whirl about in his cities and make an end of his bars and devour because of their counsels. (Hosea 11:6)
- Blow a horn in Zion, O men, and shout a war cry in my holy mountain. Let all the inhabitants of the land get agitated, for the day of Yehowah is coming, for it is near! (Joel 2:1)
- · Although they are being interwoven even as thorns and they are drunken as with their wheat beer, they will certainly be devoured like stubble fully dry. (Nahum 1:10)
- The great day of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the day of Yehowah is bitter. There a mighty man is letting out a cry. (Zephaniah 1:14)
- Awaiting and keeping close in mind the presence of the day of Yehowah, through which the heavens being on fire will be dissolved and the elements being intensely hot will melt! (2 Peter 3:12)
