Isaiah 24:8. The exultation of the tambourines has ceased, the noise of the highly elated ones has discontinued, the exultation of the harp has ceased.

[11] - References

- Strike up a melody and take a tambourine, the pleasant harp together with the stringed instrument. (Psalms 81:2)
- And I will cause to cease from the cities of Judah and from the streets of Jerusalem the voice of exultation and the voice of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, for the land will become nothing but a devastated place. (Jeremiah 7:34)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am causing to cease out of this place before the eyes of you people and in YOUR days the voice of exultation and the voice of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride. (Jeremiah 16:9)
- And I shall certainly cause all her exultation, her festival, her new moon and her Sabbath and her every festal season to cease. (Hosea 2:11)
- And no light of a lamp will ever shine in you again, and no voice of a bridegroom and of a bride will ever be heard in you again, because your traveling merchants were the top-ranking men of the earth, for by your spiritistic practice all the nations were misled. (Revelation 18:23)
- Look! That night, let it become sterile, let no joyful cry come in it. (Job 3:7)
- Upon the poplar trees in the midst of her we hung our harps.(Psalms 137:2)
- And rejoicing and joyfulness have been taken away from the orchard, and in the vineyards there is no joyful crying out, there is no

shouting done. No wine in the presses does the treader tread out. Shouting I have caused to cease. (Isaiah 16:10)

- Like the heat in a waterless country, the noise of strangers you subdue, the heat with the shadow of a cloud. The melody itself of the tyrannical ones becomes suppressed. (Isaiah 25:5)
- And I will cause the turmoil of your singing to cease, and the very sound of your harps will be heard no more. (Ezekiel 26:13)
- And the sound of singers who accompany themselves on the harp and of musicians and of flutists and of trumpeters will never be heard in you again, and no craftsman of any trade will ever be found in you again, and no sound of a millstone will ever be heard in you again. (Revelation 18:22)
