Amos 5:18... Woe to those who are craving the day of Yehowah! What, then, will the day of Yehowah mean to you people? It will be darkness, and no light.

- Those who are saying; Let his work hasten, do let it come quickly, in order, that we may see it, and let the counsel of the Holy One of Israel draw near and come, that we may know it! (Isaiah 5:19)
- Look! There are those saying to me; Where is the word of Yehowah? Let it come in, please. (Jeremiah 17:15)
- Alas! For that day is a great one, so that there is no other like it, and it is the time of distress for Jacob. But he will be saved even out of it. (Jeremiah 30:7)
- Alas for the day, because the day of Yehowah is near, and like a despoiling from the Almighty One it will come! (Joel 1:15)
- Therefore that is what I shall do to you, O Israel. As a consequence of the fact that I shall do this very thing to you, get ready to meet your God, O Israel. (Amos 4:12)
- That day is a day of fury, a day of distress and of anguish, a day of storm and of desolation, a day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick gloom. (Zephaniah 1:15)
- For it is the day belonging to Yehowah of armies. It is upon everyone self-exalted and lofty and upon everyone lifted up or low. (Isaiah 2:12)
- For it is the day of confusion and of downtreading and of confounding that the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has in the valley of the vision. There is the demolisher of the wall, and the cry to the mountain. (Isaiah 22:5)

- It is a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick gloom, like light of dawn spread out upon the mountains. There is a people numerous and mighty, one like it has not been made to exist from the indefinite past, and after it there will be none again to the years of generation after generation. (Joel 2:2)
- And Yehowah himself will certainly give forth his voice before his military force, for his camp is very numerous. For he who is carrying out his word is mighty, for the day of Yehowah is great and very fearinspiring, and who can hold up under it? (Joel 2:11)
- And it must occur in that day that there will prove to be no precious light, things will be congealed. (Zechariah 14:6)
