

YEHOWAH'S DAY - YEHOWAH HAS A SWORD AND IT MUST BE FILLED

~ **Messianic** ... **Prophecy** ... **Yehowah's Day** - Yehowah has a sword and it must be filled with blood and made greasy with fat, Yehowah has a sacrifice in Bozrah and a great slaughtering in Edom, **among non-spiritual ones of earth** (Isaiah 34:6) ^[15] - References

Isaiah 34:6 - Yehowah has a sword, it must be filled with blood, it must be made greasy with the fat, with the blood of young rams and he-goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams. For Yehowah has a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughtering in the land of Edom

- Who is this one coming from **Edom**, the one with garments of glowing colors from **Bozrah**, this one who is honorable in his clothing, marching in the abundance of his power? I, the One speaking in righteousness, the One abounding in power to save. (**Isaiah 63:1**)
- The wine trough I have trodden by myself, while there was no man with me from the peoples. And I kept treading them in my anger, and I kept trampling them down in my rage. And their spurting **blood** kept spattering upon my garments, and all my clothing I have polluted. (**Isaiah 63:3**)
- And the priest **must** make them smoke upon the altar as food, an offering **made** by fire for a restful odor. All the **fat** belongs to **Yehowah**. (**Leviticus 3:16**)
- Will it not be in that day? is the utterance of **Yehowah**. And I shall certainly destroy the wise ones out of **Edom**, and discernment out of the mountainous region of Esau. (**Obadiah 1:8**)
- When Bela died, Jobab son of Zerah from **Bozrah** began to reign instead of him. (**Genesis 36:33**)
- I shall intoxicate my arrows with **blood**, while my **sword** will eat flesh, with the **blood** of the slain and the captives, with the heads of the leaders of the enemy. (**Deuteronomy 32:42**)
- Eventually Bela died, and Jobab the son of Zerah from **Bozrah** began to reign in place of him. (**1 Chronicles 1:44**)

- And that day belongs to the Sovereign Lord, **Yehowah** of armies, the day of vengeance for avenging himself upon his adversaries. And the **sword** will certainly devour and satisfy itself and take its fill of their **blood**, for the Sovereign Lord, **Yehowah** of armies, **has** a **sacrifice** in the **land** of the north by the river Euphrates. (**Jeremiah 46:10**)
- Tell it in Egypt, O men, and publish it in Migdol, and publish it in Noph and in Tahpanhes. Say; Station yourself, making preparation also for yourself, for a **sword** will certainly devour all around you. (**Jeremiah 46:14**)
- For by my own self I have sworn, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, that nothing but an object of astonishment, a reproach, a devastation and a malediction will **Bozrah** become, and all her own cities will become devastated places to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 49:13**)
- I shall bring them down like male sheep to the **slaughtering**, like **rams** along with the **he-goats**. (**Jeremiah 51:40**)
- And as for **you** my sheep, this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** **has** said; Here I am judging between a sheep and a sheep, between the **rams** and the **he-goats**. (**Ezekiel 34:17**)
- And as regards you, O son of man, this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** **has** said; Say to the birds of every sort of wing and to all the wild beasts of the field; Collect yourselves together and come. Gather yourselves together all around to my **sacrifice**, which I am sacrificing for **you**, a **great sacrifice** on the mountains of Israel. And **you** will certainly eat flesh and drink **blood**. (**Ezekiel 39:17**)
- And I will send a fire into Teman, and it **must** devour the dwelling towers of Bozrah. (**Amos 1:12**)
- And your mighty men **must** become terrified, O Teman, for the reason that each one will be cut off from the mountainous region of Esau, because of a killing. (**Obadiah 1:9**)
- Keep silence before the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, for the day of **Yehowah** is near, for **Yehowah** **has** prepared a **sacrifice**, he **has** sanctified his invited ones. (**Zephaniah 1:7**)
