- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth. (**Daniel 2:35**)
- Look! I have made you a threshing sledge, a new threshing instrument having double-edged teeth. You **will** tread down the mountains and crush them, and the hills you **will make** just like the chaff. (**Isaiah 41:15**)
- Before the statute gives birth to anything, before the day has passed by just like chaff, before there comes upon **you** people the burning **anger** of Yehowah, before there comes upon **you** the day of Yehowah's **anger**. (**Zephaniah 2:2**)
- The **voice** of Yehowah is over the waters, the glorious God himself has thundered. Yehowah is over many waters. (**Psalms 29:3**)
- And the very sound of the wings of the cherubs made itself **heard** to the outer courtyard, like the sound of God Almighty when he speaks. (**Ezekiel 10:5**)
- And his feet were like fine copper when glowing in a furnace, and his **voice** was as the sound of many waters. (**Revelation 1:15**)
- Fright and dread **will** fall upon them. Because of the greatness of your **arm** they **will** be motionless like a stone, Until your people pass

by, O Yehowah, until the people whom you have produced pass by.
(Exodus 15:16)

- Sing to Yehowah a new song, for wonderful are the things that he has done. His right hand, even his holy **arm**, has gained salvation for him. (Psalms 98:1)
- Who has put faith in the thing **heard** by us? And as for the **arm** of Yehowah, to whom has it been revealed? (Isaiah 53:1)
- He has performed mightily with his **arm**, he has scattered abroad those who are haughty in the intention of their hearts. (Luke 1:51)
- Now the people became as men having something evil to complain about in the ears of Yehowah. When Yehowah got to hear it, then his **anger** grew hot, and a **fire** of Yehowah began to blaze against them and to consume some in the extremity of the camp. (Numbers 11:1)
- That is why the **anger** of Yehowah has grown hot against his people, and he **will** stretch out his hand against them and strike them. And the mountains **will** be agitated, and their dead bodies **will** become like the offal in the midst of the streets. In view of all this his **anger** has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 5:25)
- Yehowah is a God exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance and is disposed to rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies. (Nahum 1:2)
- And in the heavens Yehowah began to thunder, and the Most High himself began to give his **voice**, hail and burning coals of **fire**. (Psalms 18:13)
- Our God **will** come and cannot possibly keep silent. Before him there devours a **fire**, and all around him it has become exceedingly stormy weather. (Psalms 50:3)
- Yehowah, at your going forth from Seir, at your marching out of the field of Edom, earth rocked, heavens also dripped, clouds also dripped with water. (Judges 5:4)
- And it came about that while they were fleeing from before Israel and were on the descent of Beth-horon, Yehowah hurled great stones from the heavens upon them as far as Azekah, so that they died. There were more who died from the **hailstones** than those whom the sons of Israel killed with the sword. (Joshua 10:11)

- So Moses stretched out his rod toward the heavens, and Yehowah gave thunders and hail, and **fire** would run down to the earth, and Yehowah kept making it rain down hail upon the land of Egypt. (**Exodus 9:23**)
- From heaven Yehowah began to thunder, and the Most High himself began to give forth his **voice**. (**2 Samuel 22:14**)
- Have you entered into the storehouses of the snow, or do you see even the storehouses of the hail. (**Job 38:22**)
- And he kept sending out his arrows, that he might scatter them, and lightnings he shot out, that he might throw them into confusion. (**Psalms 18:14**)
- In just that way may you pursue them with your tempest and may you disturb them with your own storm wind. (**Psalms 83:15**)
- **You** **fire** and hail, snow and thick smoke, you tempestuous wind, accomplishing his word. (**Psalms 148:8**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Look! A calamity is going forth from nation to nation, and a great tempest itself **will** be roused up from the remotest parts of the earth. (**Jeremiah 25:32**)
- And I **will** bring myself into judgment with him, with pestilence and with blood, and a flooding downpour and **hailstones**, **fire** and sulphur I shall rain down upon him and upon his bands and upon the many peoples that **will** be with him. (**Ezekiel 38:22**)
