**1 Thessalonians 5:2** For you yourselves know quite well that Yehowah's day is coming exactly as a thief in the night.

- The great **day** of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the **day** of Yehowah is bitter. There a mighty man is letting out a cry. (**Zephaniah 1:14**)
- Concerning that **day** and hour nobody **knows**, neither the angels of the heavens nor the Son, but only the Father. (**Matthew 24:36**)
- Yet **Yehowah's day** will come as a **thief**, in which the heavens will pass away with a hissing noise, but the elements being intensely hot will be dissolved, and earth and the works in it will be discovered. (**2 Peter 3:10**)
- Therefore, continue mindful of how you have received and how you heard, and go on keeping it, and repent. Certainly unless you wake up, I shall come as a **thief**, and you will not **know** at all at what hour I shall come upon you. (**Revelation 3:3**)
- At daylight the murderer gets up, the proceeds to slay the afflicted and the poor one, and during the **night** he becomes a regular **thief**. (**Job 24:14**)
- You will not need to be afraid of any sudden dreadful thing, nor of the storm upon the wicked ones, because it is **coming**. (**Proverbs 3:25**)
- For their disaster will arise so suddenly, that who is aware of the extinction of those who are for a change? (**Proverbs 24:22**)
- For it is the **day** belonging to Yehowah of armies. It is upon everyone self-exalted and lofty and upon everyone lifted up or low. (**Isaiah 2:12**)

- And to them the word of Yehowah will certainly become command upon command, command upon command, measuring line upon measuring line, measuring line upon measuring line, here a little, there a little, in order, that they may go and certainly stumble backwards and actually be broken and ensnared and caught. (**Isaiah 28:13**)
- Tremble, **you** women who are at ease! Be agitated, **you** careless ones! Undress and make yourselves naked, and gird sackcloth upon the loins. (**Isaiah 32:11**)
- His watchmen are blind. None of them have taken note. All of them are speechless dogs, they are not able to bark, panting, lying down, loving to slumber. (**Isaiah 56:10**)
- We keep groaning, all of us, just like bears, and like doves we mournfully keep cooing. We kept hoping for justice, but there was none, for salvation, but it has stayed far away from us. (**Isaiah 59:11**)
- Suddenly Babylon has fallen, so that she is broken. Howl over her, **you** people. Take balsam for her pain. Perhaps she may be healed. (**Jeremiah 51:8**)
- Now the end is upon you, and I must send my anger against you, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your detestable things. (**Ezekiel 7:3**)
- And the sons of your people have said; The way of Yehowah is not adjusted right, but, as for them, it is their way that is not adjusted right. (**Ezekiel 33:17**)
- And **you** people have said; The way of Yehowah is not adjusted right. It will be each one according to his ways that I shall judge **you**, O house of Israel. (**Ezekiel 33:20**)
- And it must become one **day** that is known as belonging to Yehowah. It will not be **day**, neither will it be **night**, and it must occur that at evening time it will become light. (**Zechariah 14:7**)
- But **know** one thing, that if the householder had known in what watch the **thief** was **coming**, he would have kept awake and not allowed his house to be broken into. (**Matthew 24:43**)
- But **know** this, that if the householder had known at what hour the **thief** would come, he would have kept watching and not have let his house be broken into. (**Luke 12:39**)

- As a snare. For it will come in upon all those dwelling upon the face of all the earth. (Luke 21:35)
- And to wait for his Son from the heavens, whom he raised up from the dead, namely, Jesus, who delivers us from the wrath which is coming. (1 Thessalonians 1:10)
- Just the same, hold fast what you have until I come. (Revelation 2:25)
- Look! I am coming as a thief. Happy is the one that stays awake and keeps his outer garments, that he may not walk naked and people look upon his shamefulness. (Revelation 16:15)
