- For **Yehowah** has a day of vengeance, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (**Isaiah 34:8**)
- Hear the word of **Yehowah**, O sons of Israel, for **Yehowah** has a legal case with the inhabitants of the land, for there is no truth nor loving-kindness nor knowledge of God in the land. (**Hosea 4:1**)
- And **Yehowah** has a legal case with Judah, even to hold an accounting against Jacob according to his ways, according to his dealings he **will** repay him. (**Hosea 12:2**)
- Hear, O **you** mountains, the legal case of **Yehowah**, also **you** durable objects, **you** foundations of the **earth**, for **Yehowah** has a legal case with his people, and it is with Israel that he **will** argue. (**Micah 6:2**)
- Therefore each one according to his ways is how I shall judge **you**, O house of Israel, is the **utterance** of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**. Turn back, yes, cause a turning back from all **your** transgressions, and let nothing prove to be for **you** people a stumbling block causing error. (**Ezekiel 18:30**)

- As **regards** the **wicked**, they **will** be cut off from the very **earth**, and as for the treacherous, they **will** be torn away from it. (**Proverbs 2:22**)
- For as fire **Yehowah** himself **will** for a fact take up the **controversy**, yes, with his sword, against all **flesh**, and the slain of **Yehowah will certainly** become many. (**Isaiah 66:16**)
- By the sword they **will** die, all the sinners of my people, those who are saying; The calamity **will** not **come** near or reach as far as us. (**Amos 9:10**)
- I **will** also collect together all the **nations** and bring them down to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, and I **will put** myself on **judgment** with them there on account of my people and my inheritance Israel, whom they scattered among the **nations**, and they apportioned out my own land. (**Joel 3:2**)

- For it is the day belonging to **Yehowah** of armies. It is upon everyone self-exalted and lofty and upon everyone lifted up or low. (**Isaiah 2:12**)
- Attend to me in silence, **you** islands, and let national groups themselves regain power. Let them approach. At that time let them speak. Let us **come** up close together for the **judgment** itself. (**Isaiah 41:1**)
