

YEHOWAH - AFTER THAT IT MUST OCCUR THAT I WILL POUR

~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Yehowah** - After that it must occur that I will pour out my spirit on every sort of flesh and your sons and daughters will prophecy, your old men will dream dreams and your young men will see visions' (Joel 2:28) ^[22] - References

Joel 2:28.. And after that it must occur that I shall pour out my spirit on every sort of flesh, and **YOUR** sons and **YOUR** daughters will certainly prophesy. As for **YOUR** old men, dreams they will dream. As for **YOUR** young men, visions they will see.

- Until upon us the **spirit** is poured **out** from on high, and the wilderness **will** have become an orchard, and the orchard itself is accounted as a real forest. (**Isaiah 32:15**)
- For I shall **pour out** water upon the thirsty one, and trickling streams upon the dry place. I shall **pour out** my **spirit** upon your seed, and my blessing upon your descendants. (**Isaiah 44:3**)
- And I shall no longer conceal my face from them, because I **will pour out** my **spirit** upon the house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 39:29**)
- And in the last days, God says, I shall **pour out** some of my **spirit** upon every **sort of flesh**, and **YOUR sons** and **YOUR daughters will prophesy** and **YOUR young men will see visions** and **YOUR old men will dream dreams**. (**Acts of Apostles 2:17**)
- And I **will pour out** upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the **spirit** of favor and entreaties, and they **will certainly** look to the One whom they pierced through, and they **will certainly** wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there **will** be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (**Zechariah 12:10**)
- However, he said this concerning the **spirit** which those who put faith in him were about to receive, for as yet there was no **spirit**, because Jesus had not yet been glorified. (**John 7:39**)

- And the faithful ones that had come with Peter who were of those circumcised were amazed, because the free gift of the Holy Spirit was being poured **out** also upon people of the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 10:45**)
- This man had four **daughters**, virgins, that prophesied. (**Acts of Apostles 21:9**)
- However, Moses said to him; Are you feeling jealous for me? No, I wish that all of Yehowah's people were prophets, because Yehowah would put his **spirit** upon them! (**Numbers 11:29**)
- At once Saul sent messengers to take David. When they got to **see** the elderly ones of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing in his position over them, the **spirit** of God came to be upon Saul's messengers, and they began behaving like prophets, they also. (**1 Samuel 19:20**)
- So I entered in among the exiled people at Tel-abib, who were dwelling by the river Chebar, and I began to dwell where they were dwelling, and I kept dwelling there for seven days, stunned in the midst of them. (**Ezekiel 3:15**)
- And my **spirit** I shall put inside **you**, and I **will** act so that in my regulations **you will** walk, and my judicial decisions **you will** keep and actually carry **out**. (**Ezekiel 36:27**)
- I baptized **you** with water, but he **will** baptize **you** with Holy Spirit. (**Mark 1:8**)
- And, look! I am sending forth upon **you** that which is promised by my Father. **You**, though, abide in the city until **you** become clothed with power from on high. (**Luke 24:49**)
- Because John, indeed, baptized with water, but **you will** be baptized in Holy Spirit not many days after this. (**Acts of Apostles 1:5**)
- For the promise is to **you** and to **your** children and to all those afar off, just as many as Yehowah our God may call to him. (**Acts of Apostles 2:39**)
- At this I called to mind the saying of the Lord, how he used to say, John, for his part, baptized with water, but **you will** be baptized in Holy Spirit. (**Acts of Apostles 11:16**)
- But every woman that prays or prophesies with her head uncovered shames her head, for it is one and the same as if she were a woman with a shaved head. (**1 Corinthians 11:5**)

- Now I would like for all of **you** to speak in tongues, but I prefer that **you prophesy**. Indeed, he that prophesies is greater than he that speaks in tongues, unless, in fact, he translates, that the congregation may receive upbuilding. (**1 Corinthians 14:5**)
- The purpose was that the blessing of Abraham might come to be by means of Jesus Christ for the nations, that we might receive the promised **spirit** through our faith. (**Galatians 3:14**)
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the **spirit** says to the congregations; To him that conquers I **will** give some of the hidden manna, and I **will** give him a white pebble, and upon the pebble a new name written which no one knows except the one receiving it. (**Revelation 2:17**)
- But he tells me; Be careful! Do not do that! All I am is a fellow slave of you and of your brothers who are prophets and of those who are observing the words of this scroll. Worship God. (**Revelation 22:9**)
