- Him who is forgiving all your error, who is healing all your maladies. (**Psalms 103:3**)
- I have seen his very ways, and I began to heal him and conduct him and make compensation with comfort to him and to his mourning ones. (**Isaiah 57:18**)
- Return, **YOU** renegade sons. I shall heal **YOUR** renegade condition. Here we are! We have come to you, for you, O Yehowah, are our God. (**Jeremiah 3:22**)
- It was not because of **YOUR** being the most populous of all the peoples that Yehowah showed affection for **YOU** so that he chose **YOU**, for **YOU** were the least of all the peoples. (**Deuteronomy 7:7**)

- Is Ephraim a precious son to me, or a fondly treated child? For to the extent of my speaking against him I shall without fail remember him further. That is why my intestines have become boisterous for

him. By all means I shall have pity upon him, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 31:20**)

- Come, **you** people, and do let us return to Yehowah, for he himself **has** torn in pieces but he **will** heal us. He kept striking, but he **will** bind us up. (**Hosea 6:1**)
